What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 6 balls 9870 Deep Sea A and 4 balls 4601 Off White B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 1 chevron = 6" (15 cm) measured from peak to peak; 6 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Soft®, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g),

256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4oz (113g), 212 yd (194m) balls



Chic Chevron Throw

Add a pop of crocheted chevrons to your room with a fun throw. This graphic style is great for the modern living room, child's room or reading nook.

Throw measures 45" wide x 60" long (114.5 x 152.5 cm).

Special Stitch

dc3tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

Notes

- Throw is made in a chevron pattern which consists of a series of 3-dc "peaks" and dc3tog "valleys" with 10 dc worked between peaks and valleys. You may need to work several rows before the chevron is clearly visible.
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

THROW

With A, chain 199.

Row 1: Working in back bumps only, 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), dc in next 10 ch, [dc3tog] twice, dc in next 10 ch, *3 dc in next 2 dc, dc in next 10 ch, [dc3tog] twice, dc in next 10 ch; repeat from * 5 times, 3 dc in last ch, turn—196 dc.

Rows 2–6: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in first dc, dc in next 10 dc, [dc3tog] twice, dc in next 10 dc, *3 dc in next 2 dc, dc in next 10 dc, [dc3tog] twice, dc in next 10 dc; repeat from * 5 times, 3 dc in top of beginning ch; change to B, turn.

Repeat Row 2 eighty times and change color as in the following color sequence: Work [4 rows with B, 6 rows with A] 8 times.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = Color A, Color B; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
