What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 2 skeins each 1601 Lettuce A, 1252 Mango B, 1542 Aubergine C and 3 skeins 1934 Autumn D

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6.5mm [US K-10.5]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

GAUGE: Center of strip = 3" (7.5 cm) wide; 1 strip = 7½" (19 cm) wide. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Lacy Fall Throw

Beautiful shades are combined in ultra-cozy premium acrylic yarn for a throw you can count on to warm you and care for easily. You'll love the unusual stitch patterns and interesting texture.

Throw measures 45" wide x 57" long (114.5 x 145 cm).

Special Stitches

Surface slip st = Insert hook from right side to wrong side and then to right side again around post of indicated stitch, yarn over, draw loop to right side and through loop on hook.

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

Strip join = Ch 1, drop loop from hook, insert hook in center chain of corresponding ch-3 on previous strip, place dropped loop on hook and pull through, ch 1.

Notes

1. Throw is made of 6 strips made in rounds and rows.
2. Center of strip consists of 30 segments worked on both sides of foundation chain.
3. Each segment consists of a beginning group of 3 foundation chains, 5 double crochet stitches, and an ending group of 3 foundation chains.
4. Each surface edging row is worked on the first segment on the upper half of the center of strip, then on the second segment of the lower half, then on the third segment of the upper half, then on the fourth segment of the lower half, and continues back and forth across the halves. Surface slip stitches are worked around 3-ch groups and double crochet stitches.
5. Strips 2–6 are joined as you go to strips 1–5.

THROW

Center of Strip (make 6)

With A, ch 117.

Round 1 (right side): Dc in 5th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first 3-ch group, ch 1), [ch 1, dc] 4 times in same ch, ch 1 (first segment made), skip next 3 ch, slip st in next ch, *skip next 3 ch, [ch 1, dc] 5 times in next ch, ch 1 (segment made), skip next 3 ch, slip st in next ch; repeat from * to * 12 times, skip next 3 ch, [ch 1, dc] 11 times in next ch (last segment of upper side and first segment of lower side made); working across opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, skip next 3 ch, slip st in next ch; repeat from * to * 13 times, skip next 3 ch, [ch 1, dc] 5 times in next ch, ch 1; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch—30 segments (15 segments on each side). Fasten off.

Surface Edging

Note: Ch-3 groups are the 3 foundation chains before and after each 5-dc group.

First Side

Row 1: With right side facing, join B with surface slip st around first beginning ch-3 group of first segment, working in first segment of upper half, [ch 2, surface slip st around next dc] 5 times, ch 2, surface slip st around ending ch-3 group, *ch 1; working on next segment of lower half, surface slip st around beginning ch-3 group, [ch 2, surface slip st around next dc] 5 times, ch 2, surface slip st around ending ch-3 group, ch 1; working on next segment of upper half, surface slip st around beginning ch-3 group, [ch 2, surface slip st around next dc] 5 times, ch 2, surface slip st around ending ch-3 group; repeat from * 6 times—105 slip sts. Fasten off.

Continued...

SHOP KIT

Second Side

Note Rotate piece so last stitch of Row 1 is at your right (or at your left if you are left-handed). Beginning and ending ch-3 groups are reversed. Work **C** stitches over, but not into, **B** stitches where colors cross.

Row 1: With right side facing, join **C** with surface slip st around first beginning ch-3 group of first segment (same as ending ch-3 group of Row 1), working on first segment of upper half, [ch 2, surface slip st around next dc] 5 times, *ch 2, skip ending ch-3 group, slip st in next ch-1 space; working on next segment of lower half, skip beginning ch-3 group, [ch 2, surface slip st around next dc] 5 times, ch 1, skip ending ch-3 group, slip st in next ch-1 space; working on next segment of upper half, [ch 2, surface slip st around next dc] 5 times; repeat from * 6 times, ch 2, surface slip st around last ch-3 group—91 slip sts. Fasten off.

Strip Edging

Round 1: With right side facing, join **D** with sc in beginning ch-3 group of first segment, sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next st, ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space, [sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times, *ch 3, skip next st and next ch-1 space on current segment, skip first ch-1 space and next st on next segment, sc in next ch-1 space, [sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times*; repeat from * to * 13 times, ch 3, [sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 space] twice, sc in next st, ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space, [sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 13 times, ch 3, sc in next st, sc in next ch-1 space; join with slip st in first sc—220 sc and 32 ch-3 spaces.

Round 2: Slip st in next st, ch 1, (sc, ch 1, sc) in same st, place marker in ch-1 space, [sc, (ch 1, sc) 3 times] in center ch of next ch-3 group, [skip next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next st] 3 times, *(dc, ch 3, dc) in center ch of next ch-3 group, [skip next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next st] 3 times*; repeat from * to * 13 times, [sc, (ch 1, sc) 3 times] in center ch of next ch-3 group, [skip next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next st] twice, [sc, (ch 1, sc) 3 times] in center ch of next ch-3 group, [skip next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next st] 3 times; repeat from * to * 14 times, [sc, (ch 1, sc) 3 times] in center ch of next ch-3 group, skip next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next st; join with slip st in first sc—204 sc and 56 dc. Fasten off.

Round 3: With right side facing, join **C** with sc in marked space, place marker on this st, [(ch 1, sc) in next ch-1 space] twice, ch 1, *[3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1] twice, [3 dc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1] 14 times, 3 dc in next ch-1 space*, [ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space] 6 times, ch 1; repeat from * to * once, [(ch 1, sc) in next ch-1 space] 3 times, ch 1; join with slip st in first sc—72 sc and 186 dc. Fasten off.

Round 4: With right side facing, join **B** with sc in marked st, (ch 1, sc) in same st, place marker in ch-1 space, [(sc, ch 1, sc) in next st] twice, skip next dc, slip st in back loop only of next dc, [skip next dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next sc, skip next dc, slip st in back loop only of next dc] 30 times, skip next dc, [(sc, ch 1, sc) in next sc] 6 times, skip next dc, slip st in back loop only of next dc, [skip next dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next sc, skip next dc, slip st in back loop only of next dc] 30 times, skip next dc, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next 3 sc; join with slip st in first sc—24 sc, 120 dc, 12 ch-1 spaces, and 60 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

Joining Round

Strip 1 only

Round 5: With right side facing, join **C** with sc in marked space, remove marker, 2 sc in same space, [3 sc in next ch-1 space] twice, *(dc, ch 3, dc) in next sc, [ch 3, sc] twice in each of next 30 ch-3 spaces, [ch 3, dc] twice in next sc*, [3 sc in next ch-1 space] 6 times; repeat from * to * once, [3 sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times; join with slip st in first sc—144 sc, 8 dc, and 126 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off. Strips 2–6 only

Round 5: With right side facing, join **C** with sc in marked space, remove marker, 2 sc in same space, [3 sc in next ch-1 space] twice, (dc, strip join, dc) in next sc, [strip join, sc] twice in each of next 30 ch-3 spaces, [strip join, dc] twice in next sc, [3 sc in next ch-1 space] 6 times, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next sc [ch 3, sc] twice in each of next 30 ch-3 spaces, [ch 3, dc] twice in next sc, [3 sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times; join with slip st in first sc—156 sc, 8 dc, and 126 ch-3 spaces (including strip joins). Fasten off.

Border

Round 1: With right side facing and working across ends of strips, join **D** with slip st in ch-3 space at top right corner, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 6 dc in same space, *[(sc, ch 1, sc) in center st of next 3-sc group] 6 times, *[7 dc in space at join between strips, [(sc, ch 1, sc) in center st of next 3-sc group] 6 times] 5 times, 7 dc in next ch-3 space, slip st in next ch-3 space, [5 dc in next ch-3 space, slip st in next ch-3 space] 30 times*, 7 dc in next ch-3 space; repeat from * to * once; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—144 sc and 398 dc.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;
ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
