



What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 4 skeins 1562 Jadeite

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [J-10 US]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 2 pattern repeats = 4" (10 cm) in pattern; Rows 1–4 = 4" (10 cm). Note: one pattern repeat consists of one shell and one single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

7oz (198g), 370 yd (338m) and multicolor 5oz (141g), 230 yd (211m) skeins



Aqueous Throw

Choose your favorite color of this soft, cozy yarn and crochet a throw that is perfect for any room in your home. Since it is all one color, you won't have many ends to weave in!

Throw measures 46" wide x 58" long (117 x 147.5 cm)

Special Stitches

Ig fan (large fan) = 7 dc in indicated stitch or space.

 $\begin{array}{l} \textbf{picot} = (\text{sc, ch 2, sc)} \text{ in indicated stitch.} \\ \textbf{shell} = (3 \text{ dc, ch 2, 3 dc)} \text{ in indicated stitch.} \\ \textbf{sm fan} \text{ (small fan)} = 5 \text{ dc in indicated stitch} \\ \text{or space.} \end{array}$

Notes

- Throw is worked in turned rows. Border is worked in one joined round with right side facing.
- 2. When working border across ends of rows, work around the post of the stitch. Large and small fans are worked in rows ending with double crochet; single crochet is worked in rows ending with single crochet.

THROW

Ch 144.

Row 1 (right side): Working in back bars, dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first dc), *ch 3, skip next 2 ch, picot in next ch, ch 3, skip next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch; repeat from * across, turn—42 dc, 20 picots, and 40 ch-3 spaces.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc between first 2 dc, ch 6, skip first ch-3 space, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 space, *ch 6, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 space; repeat from * across to last ch-3 space, ch 6, skip last ch-3 space, sc between last dc and beginning ch, turn—40 sc, 20 ch-6 spaces, and 19 ch-1 spaces.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *shell in next ch-6 space, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, turn—21 sc and 20 shells.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in first sc, *ch 3, picot in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 3, 2 dc in next sc;

repeat from * across, turn—42 dc, 20 picots, and 40 ch-2 spaces.

Rows 5–100: Repeat Rows 2–4 thirty-two times.

Rows 101 and 102: Repeat Rows 2 and 3. Row 103: Ch 3, dc in first sc, *ch 2, sc in ch-2 space of next shell, ch 2, 2 dc in next sc; repeat from * across—20 sc, 42 dc, and 40 ch-2 spaces. Do not turn or fasten off.

Border

Round 1: Ch 1, working across ends of rows, Ig fan in first row, *skip next row, sc in next row, sm fan in next row; repeat from * to last 3 rows, skip next row, sc in next row, lg fan in next row; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in 2nd st, skip next 2 ch, lg fan in next picot, **skip next 2 ch, sc between next 2 dc (do not work into ch), skip next 2 ch, Ig fan in next picot; repeat from ** across, skip last 2 ch, sc in next dc, do not work into top of last dc: working across ends of rows, lq fan around last unworked dc, skip next row, sc in next row. ***sm fan in next row. skip next row. sc in next row; repeat from *** to last row, Ig fan in last row; working across top row, sc in 2nd st, skip next 2 ch, lg fan in next sc, ****skip next 2 ch, sc between next 2 dc, skip next 2 ch, Ig fan in next sc; repeat from **** across, skip last 2 ch, sc in next dc; join with slip st in beginning ch. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
