What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 2 skeins 1805 Bluebell A, 1 skein each 1542 Aubergine B, 1601 Lettuce C, 1502 Iced Aqua D, 1621 Evergreen E

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: In pattern, from point to point =5" (12.7 cm) across; 8 rows =7" (17.8 cm) measured straight up. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Splendid Ripple Throw

This striking throw proves that putting colors together in unexpected ways can give you surprisingly beautiful results. Use these colors, or choose your own five colors to crochet your own unique ripple throw!

Throw measures 55" x 45" (139.7 x 114.3 cm)

NOTE

When changing color, work last st of row until 2 loops are left on hook, drop old color, yo with new color and complete stitch. Fasten off old color.

Color Pattern

2 rows A, [2 rows each B, C, D, E, A] 6 times.

Special Abbreviations

V st (V stitch) = (dc, ch 1, dc) all in same st. dc2tog = [yo and draw up a loop in next st, yo and draw through 2 loops] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

V st dec = yo and draw up a loop in ch-1 space of next V st, yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw up a loop in dec, yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw up a loop in ch-1 space of next V st, yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

THROW

With A, ch 252.

Row 1 (Right Side): Dc in 3rd ch from hook, skip next 2 ch, [V st in next ch, skip next 2 ch] 3 times, * (V st, ch 1, V st) all in next ch, [skip next 2 ch, V st in next ch] 3 times, skip next 2 ch **; [yo and draw up a loop in next ch, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook, skip next ch] twice, yo and draw up a loop in next ch yo and draw through 2 loops on hook, yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook – dec made; skip next 2 ch, [V st in next ch, skip next 2 ch] 3 times; repeat from * to last 2 ch, end at **; dc2tog; turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, skip dc2tog, work dc2tog over first dc of first V st and ch-1 space of same V st, * [V st in next ch-1 space] 3 times, (V st, ch 1, V st) all in next ch-1 space, [V st in next ch-1 space] 3 times **, V st dec; repeat from * to last V st, end at **; dc2tog over next ch-1 space and next dc, dc in last st; turn.

Rows 3- 62: Repeat Row 2 sixty times more,

Rows 3- 62: Repeat Row 2 sixty times more, changing color according to color pattern above. At the end of Row 62, fasten off. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C, etc. = color A, B, C, etc.; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch (es); tog = together; yo = yarn over; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
