What you will need:

RED HEART® Light & Lofty®:
13 skeins 9617 Pheasant.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
9 mm [US M-13].

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 9 sts = 4" [10cm]; 6 rows
= 4" [10cm] in pattern. CHECK
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook
to obtain the gauge.

City Throw

Whether you live in the middle of the city or out in the country, you'll love to snuggle up under this Light & Lofty throw. Combine the texture of the yarn with the pattern of the stitches for a cozy blanket that will keep you warm on the coldest nights.

Throw measures 43½" x 55"
[110 cm x 140 cm].

THROW

Ch 93.

Row 1 (Right Side): 2 Dc in 3rd ch from hook, skip next 2 ch, * (sc, 2 dc) in next ch, skip next 2 ch; repeat from * to last ch; sc in last ch; turn – 91 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in first sc, skip next 2 dc, * (sc, 2 dc) in next sc, skip next 2 dc; repeat from * to last st; sc in top of ch-2; turn.

Repeat Row 2 until afghan measures 52" [132 cm] from beginning, end wrong side row.

Border

Round 1: Ch 3, dc in each dc and each sc across to next corner, ch 2, dc in each row end down length to next corner, ch 2, working across bottom of foundation ch, dc in first ch, 3 dc in base of each 3-st group across to last ch, dc in last ch, ch 2, dc in each row end up length to next corner, ch 2; join with a slip st to top of ch-3.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in each dc around and 4 dc in each corner ch-2 space; join to top of ch-3. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
