What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 3 balls each 9939 Jeweltone A and 3729 Grape C; 2 balls each 1882 Toast B and 2 balls 9518 Teal D

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 6 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Soft®, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 a).

256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4 oz (113 g), 212 yd (194 m) balls

Do-It-In Squares Throw

Each of these squares is crocheted separately, making this the ideal project to take with you to work on away from home. This design is beautiful in the colors shown, or can easily be changed to your own décor colors.

Throw measures 49" x 58" [125 cm x 147 cm].

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

picot = ch 1, slip st in top of dc just made.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

Reverse sc = ch 1, sc in st indicated, * insert hook in next st to the right and draw through a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * across.

THROW

SQUARES (Make 9 A, 6 B, 9 C, and 6 D)

Round 1: Ch 8; join with a slip st to form a ring; ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 tr in ring, [3 dc, 2 tr] 3 times in ring, 2 dc in ring; join with a slip st to top of ch-3 – 8 tr, 12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3, * dc in back loop of next tr, 3 tr in space between the 2 tr of previous round, dc in back loop of next tr **, dc in back loops of next 3 dc; repeat from * to last 2 dc, end at **; dc in back loops of last 2 dc; join in top of ch-3 – 12 tr, 20 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, * working in back loops, dc in next 2 sts, 4 tr in next tr (center tr of 3-tr group of previous row) **, dc in next 7 sts; repeat from * to last 4 sts, end at **; dc in next 4 sts; join – 28 dc, 16 tr.

Round 4: Ch 3, * dc in back loops of next 4 sts, 3 tr in space between 2nd and 3rd tr of previous round **, dc in back loops of next 11 sts; repeat from * to last 6 sts, end at **; dc in back loops of last 6 sts; join – 44 dc, 12 tr.

Round 5: Ch 3, * working in back loops, dc in next 5 sts, 4 tr in center tr of 3-tr group of previous round **, dc in next 13 sts; repeat from * to last 7 sts, end at **; dc in back loops of last 7 sts; join – 52 dc, 16 tr.

Round 6: Ch 3, * dc in back loops of next 7 sts, (tr, ch 1, tr) in space between 2nd and 3rd tr of 4-tr group of previous round **, dc in back loops of next 17 sts; repeat from * to last 9 sts; dc in back loops of last 9 sts; join – 68 dc, 8 tr, 4 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

Assembly Diagram

ASSEMBLY

Arrange 5 x 6 squares following the diagram. Holding squares wrong sides together, join **C** at left edge and working from left to right, join squares of Rows 1 and 2 with Reverse sc all the way across working in front loops only of squares. Join squares of Rows 2 and 3 with **B**, Rows 3 and 4 with **D**, Rows 4 and 5 with **C**, and Rows 5 and 6 with **B**. Turn Throw so that the first square of Row 6 is at top left. Repeat the joining process working from left to right with Reverse sc starting with **C** for top row of squares, then **B**, **D**, and **C**. Weave in ends.

BORDER

Round 1: With right side facing, join B with slip st in ch-1 space at corner of square; ch 3, 2 dc in same space (corner made), dc evenly spaced all the way around Throw having 3 dc in ch-1 space at each of remaining 3 corners; join to top of ch- 3. Fasten off.

Round 2: With right side facing, join C with slip st in center dc of 3-dc group of corner; ch 3, 2 dc in same st, ch 1, * skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from ** to next corner adjusting sts if necessary **; 3 dc in center dc of 3-dc group, ch 1; repeat from * around, end at **; join. Fasten off.

Round 3: With right side facing, join D with slip st in center dc of 3-dc group of corner; (ch 3, dc, picot, dc) all in same st as joining, ch 1, * skip next st, (dc, picot, dc) all in next ch-1 space, ch 1; repeat from * to next corner **; (2 dc, picot, dc) all in center dc of 3-dc group, ch 1; repeat from * around, end at **; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

A, B, C, D = color A, B, C, D; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); tr = treble crochet; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
