## What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:  
7 skeins 313 Aran

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:  
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Square = 7½" (17 cm).  
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any  
size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Crochet Cable Squares

*This beautifully designed classic is perfect in any room or to give as a special anniversary or wedding gift. Crocheted in one color squares (any color you wish), it is perfect to take along to keep your fingers busy wherever you go.*

Throw measures 47" x 62" (119 x 157 cm)

## Special Abbreviations

**corner** = (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) all in next ch-3 space.

**fptr (front post treble)** = [yo] twice, insert hook from front to back to front around post of st indicated, yo and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops] 3 times. Skip st behind fptr.

**cable (uses next 4 sts)** = skip next 2 sts, fptr around next 2 sts; working in front of fptr just made, fptr around first skipped st, then around next skipped st. Skip 4 sts behind cable.

**fpdc (front post double)** = yo, insert hook from front to back to front around post of st indicated, yo and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice. Skip st behind fpdc.

**DEC (decrease)** = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## THROW

### Square (Make 48)

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Ch 4; dc in 4th ch from hook, ch 3, [2 dc, ch 3] 3 times all in same ch; join with a slip st to top of beginning ch.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, corner, \* dc in next 2 dc, corner; repeat from \* around; join to top of ch-3.

**Round 3:** Slip st in next 3 dc, ch 3, corner, dc in next dc, cable, \* dc in next dc, corner, dc in next dc, cable; repeat from \* around; join.

**Round 4:** Ch 4, \* skip next dc, dc in next dc, corner, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, fpdc around next 4 fptr \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Round 5:** Ch 4, \* skip next st, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, corner, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] twice, cable \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Round 6:** Ch 4, \* dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] twice, corner, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] 3 times, fpdc around next 4 fptr \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Round 7:** Ch 4, \* dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] 3 times, corner, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] 4 times, cable \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; repeat from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew 8 squares together into 6 vertical strips, then sew strips together.

## BORDER

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join yarn in any corner ch-3 space; \*\* ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner space, \* ch 1, sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next st, [sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 5 times, dec, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 6 times, ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 1, skip seam, sc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 6 times, decrease, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 6 times; repeat from \* to next corner; repeat from \*\* around; ch 1; join with a slip st to first sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*\* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space, sc in next sc, \* ch 1, sc in next sc; repeat from \* to next corner; repeat from \*\* around; ch 1; join.

SHOP KIT



**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, skip next sc, \*\* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space, ch 1, skip next sc, \* sc in next sc, ch 1, skip next st; repeat from \* to next corner; repeat from \*\* around; join.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, slip st in next space, ch 1, \*\* (slip st, ch 2, slip st) all in ch-2 space, ch 1, \* slip st in next space, ch 1; repeat from \* to next corner; repeat from \*\* around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

### **Abbreviations**

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tr** = treble crochet; **yo** = yarn over; **\*** or **\*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
