





SKILL LEVEL EASY

What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love™: 1 skein 1538 Lilac A; 2 skeins each 1308 Tan B, 1601 Lettuce C, 1701 Hot Pink D.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10].

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 11 dc = 4"; Motif #2 = 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

7 oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m), multi color 5 oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins.

Octagons & Squares Throw

An interesting combination of octagon and square motifs come together for this eyecatching throw. Crochet it in beautiful bright shades as shown, or choose whatever colors that make you happy and enjoy it every evening as you relax.

Throw measures 47" x 58".

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Beginning bobble: Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 2 dc in indicated st leaving the last loop of each st on the hook; yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Bobble: Work 3 dc in indicated st leaving the last loop of each st on the hook; yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

THROW

Motif 1 (Make 10 with C, 10 with D)

With A, ch 5, slip st in first ch to form ring. Round 1: Beginning bobble in ring, [ch 2, bobble in ring] 7 times; ch 2; join with slip st in top of beginning bobble – 8 bobbles. Fasten off A.

Round 2: Join B with slip st in any ch-2 space; (beginning bobble, ch 2, bobble) in same space; *(ch 2, bobble, ch 2, bobble) in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around; ch 2; join with slip st in top of beginning bobble – 16 bobbles. Fasten off B.

Round 3: Join C or D with slip st in ch-2 space between beginning bobble and next bobble; (ch 3, dc) in same space, [dc in next ch-2 space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 space] 7 times; dc in next ch-2 space, 2 dc in first ch-2 space; join with hdc in top of ch-3 – 8 corner ch-2 spaces; 40 dc (5 dc each side).

Round 4: Ch 3, [dc in next 5 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in corner ch-2 space] 7 times; dc in next 5 dc, dc in first space; join with hdc in top of ch-3 – 56 dc (7 dc each side).

Round 5: Ch 3, [dc in next 7 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in corner ch-1 space] 7 times; dc in next 7 dc, dc in first space; join with hdc in top of ch-3 – 72 dc (9 dc each side).

Round 6: Ch 3, [dc in next 9 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in corner ch-1 space] 7 times; dc in next 9 dc, dc in first space; join with hdc in top of ch-3 – 88 dc (11 dc each side).

Round 7: Ch 3, [dc in next 11 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in corner ch-1 space] 7 times; dc in next 11 dc, dc in first space; join with hdc in top of ch-3 - 104 dc (13 dc each side). Fasten off. Round 8: Join B with slip st in any ch-1 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [sc in next 13 dc, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner ch-1 space] 7 times; sc in next 13 dc, sc in first ch-1 space; join with hdc in first sc - 120 dc (15 sc each side). Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Motif 2 (Make 6 with C, 6 with D)

With ${\bf C}$ or ${\bf D}$, ch 5, slip st in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: Beginning bobble in ring, [ch 2, bobble in ring] 7 times; ch 2; join with slip st in top of beginning bobble – 8 bobbles. Fasten off **C**.

Round 2: Join A with slip st in any ch-2 space; [beginning bobble, ch 3, bobble] in same space for corner; *ch 2, [bobble, ch 2, bobble] in next ch-2 space, ch 2**, [bobble, ch 3, bobble] in next ch-2 space for corner; repeat from * 3 times, ending last repeat at **; join with slip st in top of beginning bobble -16Bobbles: 4 corners. Fasten off A. Round 3: Join B with slip st in any corner ch-3 space; ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same space, *2 dc in next ch-2 space, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, 2 dc in next ch-2 space**, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in next ch-3 space; repeat from * 3 times, ending last repeat at **; 3 dc in first corner ch-3 space, ch 1; join with hdc in top of beginning ch-3 - 52 dc (13 dc each side). Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same space, [sc in next 13 dc, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner ch-2 space] 3 times; sc in next 13 dc, sc in first space; join with hdc in first sc - 60 sc (15 sc each side). Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

FINISHING

With B, slip st octagons and squares together, using layout diagram as a guide for placement.

Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); yo = yarn over; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
