



## Crochet Circles Throw

*Using a multi-color print yarn for the background of each square gives this throw an interesting texture.*

*It's easy to crochet and is a good take-with-you project. Just 12 squares!*

**Throw measures 45½" x 58"**

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** 3 skeins each 528 Medium Purple **A** and 315 Artist Print **D**; 1 skein each 320 Cornmeal **B**, and 256 Carrot **C**.

**Crochet Hook:** 6.5 mm [US K-10 ½].  
Yarn Needle.

**GAUGE:** First 3 Rounds = 4" in diameter, Motif = 12½" Square. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

### THROW

#### Motif (make 12):

With **A**, ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 1, 12 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc—12 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), \*dc in next sc, ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4—12 dc. Fasten off.

**Round 3:** With right side facing, join **B** in any dc of Round 2, ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), \*(dc, ch 1) in next ch-1 space, \*\* (dc, ch 1) in next dc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4—24 dc. Fasten off.

**Round 4:** With right side facing, join **C** in any dc of Round 3, ch 3, (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each dc and each ch-1 space around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—48 dc.

**Round 5:** Ch 5, (counts as first dc, ch 2), skip next dc, \*dc in next dc, ch 2, skip next dc; repeat from \* around, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5—24 dc. Fasten off.

**Round 6:** With right side facing, join **A** in any ch-2 space of Round 5, ch 3, dc in same space, ch 1, \*2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch 3—24 2-dc groups. Fasten off.

**Round 7:** With right side facing, join **D** in any dc of Round 6, ch 4 (counts as tr), (tr, ch 3, 2 tr) in same st for corner, \*[ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st] twice, [ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in next st] 4 times, [ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st] twice, ch 1, skip 1 st\*\*, [2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr] in next st for corner; repeat from \* around ending last repeat at \*\*, ch 1, skip 1 st, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-4.

**Round 8:** Ch 3, dc in next tr, \*(2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 space, dc in each tr and each ch-1 space to next corner; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3.

**Round 9:** Ch 3, dc in each dc around, work (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in each corner ch-3 space; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

**Round 10:** With right side facing, join **A** in any corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same corner ch-3 space, skip 1 dc, \*[2 dc in next dc, skip 1 dc] to next corner, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 space, skip 1 dc, repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3.



**Round 11:** Slip st across to corner ch-2 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same corner ch-2 space, work 2 dc between each 2-dc group around, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each corner ch-2 space; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

### Assembly

With right sides together, whip st or crochet blocks together in a rectangle, 3 blocks wide by 4 blocks long. Weave in ends.

### Border

**NOTE:** For Round 1 only each intersection of joining seam counts as 3 sts as follows: space on each side of each joining seam counts as one st each side, joining seam counts as one st.

**Round 1:** With right side of Throw facing, join **A** in first dc to left of top right-hand corner, ch 1, sc in each of first 5 dc, \*[skip next st, sc in each of next 5 sts]\* across to within 1 dc from next corner, sc in next st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space; repeat from \* to \* across to within 2 dc from next corner, skip next st, sc in next st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* around; join with slip st in beginning sc—93 sc on short sides; 123 sc on each long side.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in first st, [skip next st, 2 dc in next st] around, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each corner ch-2 space; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

**Rounds 3-4:** With right side facing, join **C** in any dc, ch 3, dc in each dc around, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each corner ch-2 space; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off at end of Round 4.

**Round 5:** With **B**, repeat Round 3.

**Round 6:** With right side facing, join **A** in any dc, ch 3, dc in each dc around, working 6 dc in each corner ch-2 space; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3.

**Round 7:** Ch 1, sc in each dc around, join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **A, B, C, D** = Colors A, B, C, D; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
