What you will need:

RED HEART® Kids™: 2 skeins each 2846 Cruise Blue A, 2735 Pixie Pink B, and 2652 Lime C; 3 skeins 2931 Playful D.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9].

Yarn needle.

Gauge: 13 sts = 4" (10 cm); 9 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Stripes & Blocks Throw

No one will ever believe how easy it is to crochet this bright and happy throw! A simple stitch pattern makes it easy, the colors make it fun.

SHOP KIT

Throw measures 49" (124 cm) square, excluding border.

THROW

Wide Panel 1

With C, ch 24.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, * dc in next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across; turn – 23 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), skip first sc, * sc in next dc, dc in next sc; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc, * dc in next sc, sc in next dc; repeat from * across; turn. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern until 16 rows have been completed changing to D in last st of Row 16.

Continue in pattern working color sequence as follows: 16 rows D, 16 rows A, [2 rows B, 2 rows A] 4 times, 16 rows B, 16 rows C, and 16 rows D. Fasten off.

Wide Panel 3

Work same as Panel 1 beginning with 16 rows A, then 16 rows B, [2 rows C, 2 rows B] 4 times, 16 rows C, 16 rows D, [2 rows A, 2 rows D] 4 times, and 16 rows A.

Wide Panel 5

Work same as Panel 1 beginning with 16 rows B, then [2 rows D, 2 rows A] 4 times, 16 rows D, 16 rows B, [2 rows C, 2 rows B] 4 times, 16 rows A, and 16 rows C.

Wide Panel 7

Work same as Panel 1 beginning with [2 rows B, 2 rows D] 4 times, then 16 rows C, 16 rows B, [2 rows A, 2 rows B] 4 times, 16 rows C, 16 rows D, and [2 rows A, 2 rows C] 4 times.

Wide Panel 9

Work same as Panel 1 beginning with 16 rows D, then 16 rows A, [2 rows B, 2 rows C]

4 times, 16 rows D, 16 rows A, [2 rows B, 2 rows D] 4 times, and 16 rows B.

Narrow Panel 2

With B, ch 12. Repeat Rows 1-3 same as for Panel 1 across 11 sts, then repeat Rows 2 and 3 until 112 rows have been completed. Fasten off.

Narrow Panel 4

Work same as Narrow Panel 2 with C.

Narrow Panel 6

Work same as Narrow Panel 2 with A.

Narrow Panel 8

Work same as Narrow Panel 2 with B.

Assembly

Weave strips together with Wide Panel 1 at far left, then Narrow Panel 2 to the right, then Wide Panel 3 to the right, and so on ending with Panel 9 at the far right.

Edging

Round 1: With right side facing, join C in any st; ch 1, work sc evenly around entire throw, working 3 sc in each corner; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Round 2: Join D in any sc; ch 1, * sc in next sc to the right; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations: A, B, C, etc. = color A, B, C, etc.; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
