What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR}: 3$ skeins 400 Grey Heather A, 2 skeins 624 Tea Leaf $B, 1$ skein each 320 Cornmeal C, 358 Lavender D, and 706 Perfect Pink E

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hooks: 4.50 mm [US G-6], 5 mm [US H-8] and 5.50 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Octagon Motif measures $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ [ 14 cm ] across with smallest hook; Insert Motif measures 214" [ 5.7 cm ] across with middle size hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge Saver ${ }^{\circledR}$, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd ( 333 m ); multi color, heather and print 50 oz (141 g), 244 yd ( 223 m ), flecks 50 oz (141 g), 260 yd ( 238 m ) skeins


## A Garden Of Flowers Throw

Nothing says Spring like a bed of flowers. Crochet this beautiful throw and bring a little outside in. This will brighten up a room and your day!

## Throw Measures 45 " x 56 " $[114 \mathrm{~cm} \mathrm{x} 142 \mathrm{~cm}]$

## THROW

Octagon Motif (Make 26 C, 27 D , and 27 E )
Round 1: With flower color and smallest hook ch 2; 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with a slip st to first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, (sc, 2 dc ) in same sc as joining, [(sc, 2 dc) in next sc] 7 times; join. Fasten off.

Round 3 : Working behind petals of Round 2, join yarn between any 2 sc of Round 1 ; ch 1 , sc in same space, ch 3 , [sc between next 2 sc, ch 3] 7 times; join -8 ch- 3 spaces.

Round 4: Slip stitch into ch-3 space, ch 3, 2 dc in same space, ch 2 , [3 dc in next ch-3 space, ch 2] 7 times; join with a slip st in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Round 5: Join B in any ch-2 space; ch 2, (dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same space, ch 1 , [(2 dc, ch 2 , 2 dc ) in next ch-2 space, ch 1] 7 times; join in top of ch-2. Fasten off.

Round 6: Join A in any ch-2 space; ch 2, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same space, ch 1, dc in ch-1 space, ch 1, [(2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc ) in next ch-2 space, ch 1 , dc in ch- 1 space, ch 1$] 7$ times; join. Fasten off.

## Insert Motifs (Make 63)

Round 1: With B and middle size hook ch 2; 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with a slip st to first sc.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same sc as joining, * ch 3, [2 dc in next sc] twice; repeat from * twice more; ch 3, 2 dc in last sc, join in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

## Assembly

With right sides facing you and A , whipstitch Octagon Motifs together following diagram, having 10 rows of 8 motifs each. With $\mathbf{B}$ sew in Insert Motifs.

## Edging

With right side facing and largest hook join A in any corner dc of Round 6 , (sc, ch $3, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in same st, * ch 3, sc in ch-3 space, ch 3, skip next ch-1 space, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc; repeat from * to seam; ch 3, sc in seam, ch 3, skip next ch-1 space, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

A, B, C, etc. = color A, B, C, etc.; ch = chain; $\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet; $\mathrm{mm}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); * $=$ repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
