## What you will need:

RED HEART® ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 8 skeins 661 Frosty Green.

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9].

GAUGE: 17 sts and 20 rows in pattern $=6$ ". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

NOTE: Leave sc behind each post stitch unworked.


RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd ( 333 m ); multicolor, heather and print $50 z$ ( 141 g ), $244 \mathrm{yd}(223 \mathrm{~m})$, flecks 5 $0 z(141 \mathrm{~g}), 260 \mathrm{yds}(238 \mathrm{~m})$ skeins.

## Afghan measures 50" x 60".

## Special Abbreviations:

Spiked front post double crochet (sFPdc): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front again, around the post of the next sc 2 rows below, yo and pull up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.
Front post double crochet (FPdc): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front again, around post of indicated st, yo and pull up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Reverse single crochet (rsc): Working from left to right, insert hook into next st, yo, pull up loop, yo, draw through both loops on hook.

Chevron Pattern A (Worked over 22 sts):
Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in next 22 sts.
Row 2: Sc in next 22 sts.
Row 3: [Sc in next sc, sFPdc] twice, sc in next 5 sc, [sFPdc] 4 times, sc in next 5 sc , [sFPdc, sc in next sc] twice.
Row 4: Repeat Row 2.
Row 5: [Sc in next sc, FPdc] twice, sc in next 4 sc, sFPdc, FPdc, sc in next 2 sc , FPdc, sFPdc, sc in next 4 sc , [FPdc, sc in next sc] twice. Row 6: Repeat Row 2.
Row 7: [Sc in next sc, FPdc] twice, sc in next 3 sc, sFPdc, FPdc, sc in next 4 sc , FPdc, sFPdc, sc in next 3 sc , [FPdc, sc in next sc] twice. Row 8: Repeat Row 2.
Row 9: [Sc in next sc, FPdc] twice, sc in next 2 sc, sFPdc, FPdc, sc in next 6 sc , FPdc, sFPdc, sc in next 2 sc, [FPdc, sc in next sc] twice.
Row 10: Repeat Row 2.
Row 11: [Sc in next sc, FPdc] twice, sc in next sc, sFPdc, FPdc, sc in next 2 sc, [sFPdc] 4 times, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{FPdc}$, sFPdc, sc in next sc, [FPdc, sc in next sc] twice.
Row 12: Repeat Row 2.
Row 13: [Sc in next sc, FPdc] twice, [sFPdc, FPdc, sc in next 2 sc ] twice, FPdc, sFPdc, sc
in next 2 sc, FPdc, sFPdc, [FPdc, sc in next sc] twice.
Row 14: Repeat Row 2.
Repeat Rows 7-14 for Chevron Pattern A.
Diamond Pattern B (Worked over 35 sts): Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in next 35 sts.
Rows 2 and 38: [Sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 5 times, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, sc in next 7 sc , [tr in next sc, sc in next sc] 5 times. Row 3 and 37: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 4 and 36: [Tr in next sc, sc in next sc] 5 times, sc in next 6 sc , tr in next sc, sc in next sc , tr in next sc, sc in next 6 sc , [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 5 times.
Row 5 and 35: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 6 and 34: [Sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 4 times, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] twice, sc in next 7 sc , [tr in next sc, sc in next sc] 4 times.
Row 7 and 33: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 8 and 32: [Tr in next sc, sc, in next sc] 4 times, sc in next 6 sc , tr in next sc, [sc in next sc , tr in next sc] 3 times, sc in next 6 sc , [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 4 times.
Row 9 and 31: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 10 and 30: [Sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 3 times, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 4 times, sc in next 7 sc , [tr in next sc, sc in next sc] 3 times.
Row 11 and 29: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 12 and 28: [Tr in next sc, sc in next sc] 3 times, sc in next 6 sc, tr in next sc, [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 5 times, sc in next 6 sc, [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 3 times. Row 13 and 27: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 14 and 26: [Sc in next sc, tr in next sc] twice, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, [sc in next sc , tr in next sc] 6 times, sc in next 7 sc , [tr in next sc, sc in next sc] twice.
Row 15 and 25: Repeat Row 1.

## Yarnspirations

Rows 16 and 24: Tr in next sc, sc in next sc, tr in next sc, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc , [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 7 times, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, sc in next sc, tr in next sc.
Row 17 and 23: Repeat Row 1.
Rows 18 and 22 : Sc in next sc , tr in next sc, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 8 times, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc .

## Row 19 and 21: Repeat Row 1.

Row 20: Tr in next sc, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc, [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 9 times, sc in next 7 sc , tr in next sc.
Row 39: Repeat Row 1 .
Row 40: [Tr in next sc, sc in next sc] 6 times, sc in next 11 sc , [sc in next sc, tr in next sc] 6 times.

Repeat Rows 1-40 for Diamond Pattern B.

## THROW

Ch 139.
Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across; turn - 138 sc. Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, work Chevron Pattern A Row 2 across next 22 sts, [work Diamond Pattern B Row 2 across next 35 sts, work Chevron Pattern A Row 2 across next 22 sts] twice, sc in last sc; turn.

Continue in pattern established in Row 2, working [Diamond Pattern B Rows 1-40] 4 times, then Rows 1-38 once, ending with Chevron Pattern A Row 14 (Wrong Side Row); turn to work Edging on Right Side.

## Edging

Round 1: Ch 1, 3 sc in first st for corner; sc in each st across top, 3 sc in corner, sc evenly down side (work approximately 4 sc per every 5 rows), 3 sc in corner, sc across lower edge, 3 sc in corner, sc evenly up next side; join with a slip st to first sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, rsc in each sc around entire afghan; join to first st. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color $C$ etc; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; $\mathrm{mm}=$ millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) $=$ stitch(es); tr = treble (triple) crochet; yo = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
