Kids Cabin Throw

Take a traditional quilt pattern, add bright, vivid colors, and create the perfect throw for your favorite child!

What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
2 skeins 950 Mexicana A; 1 skein each 885 Delft Blue B, 368 Paddy Green C, 324 Bright Yellow D, 254 Pumpkin E, 319 Cherry Red F, and 356 Amethyst G.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [US J-10].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: One Square = 8" x 8" (20 X 20) cm. CHECK YOUR GAUGE.
Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198

g), 364 yd (333 m); multi color, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yd (238 m) skeins.

SHOP KIT

Throw measures 43" x 59" (109 x 150) cm including border.

SQUARE 1 (Make 12)

With B ch 6; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3, 15 dc in ring; join with a slip st to top of ch-3 – 16 sts.

Round 2: (On this round only work in the space between the posts of the dc instead of under the 2 top loops.) Slip st into the space between the ch-3 and the post of the next dc, (ch 3, 2 dc) all in same space, ch 1, [skip next 2 dc, 3 dc in next space, ch 1] 7 times; join with a slip st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Round 3: With right side facing attach A in any ch-1 space; ch 7, dc in same space, [ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in next ch-1 space, ch 2, (dc, ch 4, dc) all in next ch-1 space] 3 times, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in last ch-1 space, ch 2; join with a slip st to 3rd ch of ch-7.

Round 4: (Slip st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in first space, * [2 dc in next ch-2 space] 3 times **, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in next ch-4 space; repeat from * around, end at **; join with a slip st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Now work in rows across 2 sides as follows:

Row 1: With right side facing, attach B in any ch-3 space; ch 3, dc in next 12 sts; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in ch-3 space – corner group made; dc in next 12 sts, dc in ch-3 space; turn – 15 sts each side.

Row 2: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in each dc to corner, work corner group, dc in each dc across and in top of ch-3; turn – 17 sts each side.

Row 3: Repeat Row 2 – 19 sts each side. Fasten off.

Now work in rows across remaining 2 sides and across the ends of Rows 1, 2 and 3.

Row 4: With right side facing, attach C to top of last dc of Row 3; ch 3, work 4 dc evenly across row ends, dc in corner space, dc in next 12 dc, work corner group, dc in next 12 dc, dc in corner space, work 5 dc evenly across rows ends; turn – 20 sts each side.

Row 5: Repeat Row 2 with C – 22 sts each side.

Row 6: Repeat Row 2 with C – 24 sts each side. Fasten off.

SQUARE 2 (Make 11)

Work same as for Square 1 changing color sequence to D, A, D, E.

SQUARE 3 (Make 12)

Work same as for Square 1 changing color sequence to F, A, F, G.

Weave in ends. Sew squares together following diagram.

BORDER-Round 1: With right side facing, attach A in any dc; ch 3, work dc evenly around, working corner group in each of 4 corners as before; join with a slip st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Round 2: With right side facing, attach B in any dc; ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each corner space; join with a slip st to first sc. Fasten off.

Continued...



Round 3: With right side facing, attach **C** in any sc; ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in center sc of each corner; join with a slip st to first sc. Fasten off.

Rounds 4-7: Repeat Round 3 with **D, E, F** and **G**. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **A, B, C**, etc. = color **A, B, C**, etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
