

# Original Spectrum Throw 

This beautiful piece has been a long time favorite. It's a traditional style with contemporary color shades that work in many home decorating schemes.

Throw measures 57" x 73".
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 4 skeins 312 Black MC; 1 skein each 512 Turqua A, 358 Lavender B, 624 Tea Leaf C, 347 Lt. Periwinkle D, 320 Cornmeal E, 885 Delft Blue F, and 774 Lt Raspberry $\mathbf{G}$.

Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [US I-9].
Yarn needle.
GAUGE: Square measures $53 / 4$ across. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## THROW <br> Square (See below for color sequence)

Ch 6; join with a slip st to form a ring.
Round 1: Ch 4, 3 tr in ring, [ch 3, 4 tr in ring] 3 times, ch 3 ; join with a slip st to top of ch-4. Fasten off.

Round 2: Attach yarn in any ch-3 space. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in same space, sc in next 4 sts, [(3 dc, ch 2,3 dc) all in next space, sc in next 4 sts] 3 times; join to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Round 3: Attach yarn in any ch-2 space. Ch 1, * (2 sc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{sc}$ ) all in ch-2 space, sc in next 2 dc , hdc in next dc, dc in next 4 sc , hdc in next dc, sc in next 2 dc ; repeat from * around; join to first sc. Fasten off.

Round 4: Attach yarn in any ch-2 space. Ch 1, * (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space, sc in each st to next corner space; repeat from * around; join. Fasten off.

Round 5: Attach yarn in sc before corner space. Ch 2, * (hdc, ch 2, hdc) all in next space, hdc in next 7 sc ; [yo] twice, insert hook from the front to the back to the front around the post of the dc of Round 3 below next sc and draw loop through, [yo and through 2 loops] 3 times - ftr (front post treble) worked; ftr around next dc of Round 3, skip 2 sc of Rnd 4 behind ftrs **, hdc in next 7 sc; repeat from * to last 6 sc , end at **; hdc in last 6 sc ; join to top of ch-2. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## SQUARES 1, 3 and 8 (Make 13 each)

Work Rounds 1-5 in the following color sequence:
Square 1: A, B, C, D, MC.
Square 3: F, C, A, B, MC.
Square 8: C, A, D, B, MC.
SQUARES 4 and 7 (Make 12 each)
Work Rounds $1-5$ in the following color sequence:
Square 4: C, F, D, E, MC.
Square 7: D, E, G, C, MC.
SQUARES 2, 5, 6 and 9 (Make 11 each)
Work Rounds 1-5 in the following color sequence:
Square 2: E, D, F, G, MC.
Square 5: B, G, E, A, MC.
Square 6: G, A, B, F, MC.
Square 9: A, E, B, G, MC.
Sew squares together through back loops following diagram.

## Border

With right side facing attach MC in any corner ch-2 space and work 2 rounds sc evenly around, increasing and decreasing at outer and inner points on each round to keep work flat; join each round. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
