



GAUGE: first square of center panel = 4" long x 3.5" wide.

Special Abbreviation

dec (decrease) = draw up a loop in next 2 sc, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES: Work center panel to begin: make 13 squares, joining 2nd-13th at one end ch-2 space as specified while working Round 4. Then work as indicated on each side of panel.

THROW

Center Panel-1st Square

Round 1: With **A**, ch 4, join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring; 8 sc in ring; join with a slip st in first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) in next sc, sc in next sc, (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) in next sc *, sc in next sc; repeat from * to * once more; join to first sc – 4 sc each side between corner ch-2 spaces

Rounds 3-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 space; join. Fasten off at end of Round 4 – 8 sc between ch-2 spaces.



Berry Zig-Zag Throw

Inspired by the graphic zigzag patterns in popular Missoni designs, this beautiful throw is a striking addition to a neutral color scheme. Or, of course, you can change the colors to your own liking and needs.

Throw measures 48" x 57½".

Red Heart® With Love™: 3 skeins 1907 Boysenberry **A**, 1 skein each 1303 Aran **B**, 1538 Lilac **C**, 1541 Grape Jam **D**, 1302 Caramel **E**, 1601 Lettuce **F**, and 1012 Black **G**.

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10].
Yarn needle.



2nd Square

Work Rounds 1-3 same as for First Square.

Joining Round 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc to corner, sc in ch-2 space, ch 1, drop loop from hook and insert into corner space of previous square and back into dropped loop, draw loop through, ch 1; complete square as before without additional joins.

3rd-13th Square

Work as for 2nd Square, making sure that squares are joined at opposite corners to form a strip.

When all 13 squares are joined, work across each side.

***** Row 1:** With right side facing, join **A** in first sc of strip after the outermost ch-2 space; ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch 2 space, sc in next 8 sc **, skip next 2 corner ch-2 spaces, sc in next 8 sc; repeat from * across, end at **; turn – 9 sc each side of points.

Row 2: Ch 1, dec, sc in next 7 sc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 space, ** sc in next 8 sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 8 sc; repeat from * to last 9 sc, end at **; sc in last 7 sc, dec; turn.

Rows 3-9: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off at end of Row 9. ***

Rows 10-60: Repeat Row 2 for pattern in the following color sequence always beginning a new color with the right side facing:

2 rows **F**, 1 row **G**, 3 rows **E**, 1 row **G**, 2 rows **C**, 5 rows **A**, 1 row **B**, 3 rows **D**, 1 row **E**, 2 rows **B**, 3 rows **A**, **** 2 rows **F**, 3 rows **G**, 1 row **C**, 3 rows **D**, 1 row **C**, 6 rows **A**, 2 rows **F**, 1 row **G**, 3 rows **E**, 2 rows **B**, 1 row **G**, 2 rows **C**. ****

Repeat from *** to *** and then from **** to **** on opposite side of panel.

Border

Round 1: With right side facing, join **A** in first sc of Row 60 at top left corner; ch 1, **** (sc, ch 2, sc) in first sc, dec, sc in next 6 sc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc in next 8 sc, skip next 2 sc **, sc in next 8 sc; repeat from * to last 9 sc, end at **; sc in next 6 sc, dec, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in last sc; working across short edge, *** ch 1, sc in next row end (or in center ch-2 space at center); repeat from *** across; ch 1; repeat from **** around; join in first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, **** (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, dec, sc in next 7 sc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc in next 8 sc, skip next 2 sc **, sc in next 8 sc; repeat from * to last 9 sc, end at **; sc in next 7 sc, dec, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in ch-2 space; working across short edge, ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc, *** ch 1, skip next space, sc in next sc; repeat from *** to last sc; ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from **** around; join in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
