



## Windsor Ripple Throw

*Never made a ripple throw? Here's your chance to make an easy classic piece in contemporary colors. This design repeats one row once you have worked the set up row. What could be easier?*

Throw measures 48" x 57".

**Red Heart® With Love™**: 2 skeins each 1530 Violet **A** and 1814 True Blue **D**; 1 skein each 1907 Boysenberry **B**, 1701 Hot Pink **C**, 1401 Pewter **E** and 1805 Bluebell **F**.

**Crochet Hook**: 6.0 mm [US J-10].

**GAUGE**: 1 pattern repeat (16 sts) = 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub>". 6 rows in pattern = 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>". **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.**

### Special Stitches

**dc2tog**: Yo, insert hook in next st, yo and draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, yo, insert hook in next st, yo and pull up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook, yo and draw through remaining 3 loops on hook.

### Color Sequence

Work in the following color sequence throughout: \*3 rows **A**, 2 rows **B**, 1 row **C**, 3 rows **D**, 2 rows **E**, 1 row **F**; repeat from \* 5 times; 3 rows **A**

### THROW

With **A**, ch 148.

**Row 1**: Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, \*dc in next 5 ch sts, [dc2tog in next 2 ch sts] twice, dc in next 5 ch, 2 dc in each of next 2 ch sts; repeat from \* 7 times, dc in next 5 ch sts, [dc2tog in next 2 ch sts] twice, dc in last 7 ch sts; turn – 9 pattern repeats.

**Row 2**: Ch 3, dc in first dc, \*dc in next 5 sts, [dc2tog in next 2 sts] twice, dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts; repeat from \* 7 times, dc in next 5 sts, [dc2tog in next 2 sts] twice, dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in last st; turn.

**Rows 3-75**: Maintaining color sequence as established, repeat row 2. At the end of Row 75, fasten off. Weave in ends.



**Red Heart® With Love™**, Art. E400, available in solid color 7oz (198g), 390 yd (357m) and multi color 5oz (141g), 230 yd (211m) skeins.

**ABBREVIATIONS**: **A, B, C, D, E, F** = Color A, B, C, D, E, F; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
