



Primrose Lane Throw

Choose vibrant colors like ours for a throw that adds a bright spot of color to your room. Of course, you could also crochet this throw in neutrals or soft shades for a calmer room accessory.

Throw measures: 44½" x 56½"

Red Heart® "Soft", 2 balls each 4420 Guacamole **A**, 9344 Chocolate **B**, 9518 Teal **C**, and 2515 Turquoise **D**.

Crochet hook: 6mm [US J-10].
Stitch marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4"; 6 rows = 4" in pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

Notes

Panels are made first. Only the first panel is given an edging. Subsequent panels are joined on the left edge to previous panel. All edging rounds are worked on the right side.

PANEL 1

Make 3 in **C**

Make 2 in **D**

Ch 16

Row 1: Working in back loops of ch, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 12 ch, ch 3; turn (beginning ch-3 counts as first dc of next row) – 13 dc.

Row 2: Dc in each remaining dc across, ch 3; turn – 13 dc.

Row 3: Dc in next 4 dc, ch 5, skip 3 dc, dc in next 5 dc. Ch 3, turn.

Row 4: Dc in next dc, ch 6, sc in next ch-5 space, ch 6, skip next 3 dc, dc in last 2 dc, ch 3; turn – 4 dc, 1 sc, 2 ch-6 spaces.

Row 5: Dc in next dc, 3 dc in ch-6 space, ch 5, 3 dc in next ch-6 space, dc in last 2 dc, ch 3; turn – 10 dc, 1 ch-5 space.

Row 6: Dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in ch-5 space, dc in last 5 dc, ch 3; turn – 13 dc.

Rows 7 and 8: Dc in next dc and in each remaining dc across, ch 3; turn – 13 dc.

Rows 9-80: Repeat rows 3 – 8 twelve times.

Rows 81-85: Repeat rows 3 – 7, once. Fasten off.

PANEL 2

Make 4 in **A**

Row 1: Repeat row 1 of panel 1.

Rows 2-5: Repeat row 2 of panel 1.

Rows 6-11: Repeat 3-8 of panel 1.

Rows 12-83: Repeat rows 3-8 of panel 1, 12 times.

Rows 84-85: Repeat row 2 of panel 1. Fasten off.

Work edging around panel 1, then join together remaining panels while working border round. Join left side of each panel from top to bottom to panel on the left.

FIRST PANEL EDGING

Round 1: With **B**, join with sc in end of row 1 on right hand edge of first panel. Work up right edge: (ch 2, sc) in same row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in end of each row, (sc, ch 4, sc) in top of final row – 172 sc, 85 ch-2 spaces, 1 ch-4 space.

Work across top: [skip 1 dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc] 5 times, skip 1 dc, (sc, ch 4, sc) in the top of the last st – 12 sc, 5 ch-2 spaces, 1 ch-4 space.

Work down left edge: (sc, ch 2, sc) in side of remaining rows, (sc, ch 4, sc) in bottom corner of last row – 172 sc, 85 ch-2 spaces, 1 ch-4 space.

Work across bottom edge: [skip 1 ch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in underside of each ch] 5 times, skip next ch, (sc, ch 4, sc) in last corner ch; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.



REMAINING PANELS

To join panels from top corner to bottom corner: continuing in pattern st, join panels while working left hand side to next panel on the left as follows.

Round 1: With **B** and right side facing, join with sc in end of row 1 on right hand edge of first panel. Work up right edge: (ch 2, sc) in same row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in end of each row, (sc, ch 4, sc) in top of final row – 172 sc, 85 ch-2 spaces, 1 ch-4 space.

Work across top: [skip 1 dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc] 5 times, skip 1 dc, (sc, ch 2, drop hook from loop, insert hook in adjacent ch-4 space of previous panel, place dropped loop on hook and draw through the ch-4 space, ch 2, sc) in the top of the last st – 12 sc, 5 ch-2 spaces, 1 ch-4 join space.

Work down left edge: (sc, ch 1, drop hook from loop, insert hook in adjacent ch-2 space of previous panel, place dropped loop on hook and draw through the ch-2 space, ch 1, sc) in side of remaining rows, (sc, ch 2, drop hook from loop, insert hook in adjacent ch-4 space of previous panel, place dropped loop on hook and draw through the ch-4 space, ch 2, sc) in the bottom of the last st – 172 sc, 85 ch-2 joining spaces, 1 ch-4 join space.

Continue working along bottom edge in pattern as for Panel 1; join with slip stitch in first sc. Fasten off.

Repeat joining for all subsequent panels, do not fasten off after panel 9.

Edging

Round 1: Skip next sc, slip st in next ch 2 space, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same ch-2 space, *ch 2, sc in next ch-2 space (or in each ch-4 space at joining seams); repeat from * around working at 4 corners: ch 2, (sc, ch 4, sc) in corner ch-4 spaces, ch 2; join with slip st in next ch-2 space.

Round 2: Skip next sc, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch 2 space around and (sc, ch 2, sc, ch 3, sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch 4 space; continue in pattern for all four sides; join with slip in first sc. Fasten off.

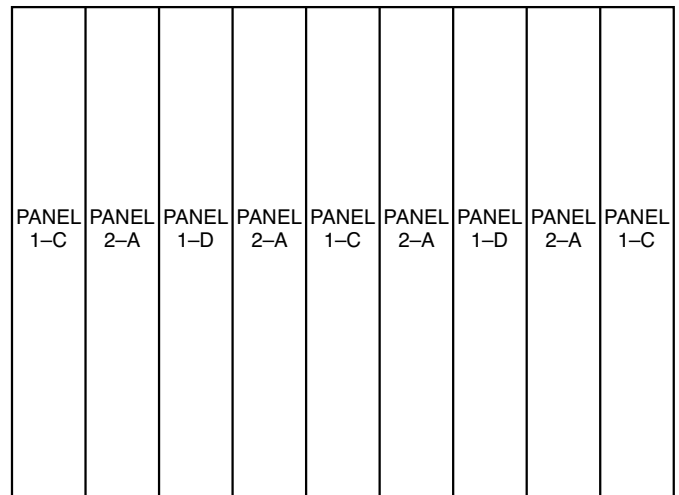
FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block lightly.



RED HEART® “Soft”, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (140 g), 256 yd (234 m), print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4oz (113g), 212 yd (194m) balls.

Abbreviations: **A, B, C** = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **dc**; double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **mm** = millimeters; * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
