Super Quick Throw

By holding four strands of yarn together and crocheting them as one, your throw will progress in record time! You'll love cozying up on the sofa with this lush crocheted throw.

Designed by Marilyn Coleman.

Throw measures 48" x 59".

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 3 skeins each 311 White **A**, 316 Soft White **B**, 313 Aran **C**, and 661 Frosty Green **D**.

Crochet Hook: 11.5mm [US P-16].

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 6 sts = 5"; 6 rows = 9" in pattern (4 strands held together). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE**. **Use any size hook to obtain the gauge**.

SPECIAL STITCH

v-st = v Stitch – (double crochet, chain 1, double crochet) in indicated st or space.

NOTE: Hold one strand of each of 4 colors together as one throughout.

THROW

Ch 60.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 58 sts.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next dc and in each dc across, dc in top of ch-3; turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next dc, skip next dc; v-st in next dc; * skip next 2 dc, v-st in next dc; repeat from * to last 3 sts; skip next dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of ch-3; turn.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next dc, skip next dc, v-st in next ch-1 sp, * skip next 2 dc, v-st in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to last 3 sts; skip next dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of ch-3; turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, * dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * to last st; dc in top of ch-3; turn.

Repeat Rows 2-7 five times, repeat Rows 2 and 3 again. Turn and, with right side facing, work 1 round sc evenly around entire outer edge, taking care to keep work flat; join with a slip st to first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
