## What you will need:

**RED HEART Soft™:** 10 balls  
4601 Off White **A** and 2 balls  
9518 Teal **B**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
9mm [US N-15]

Yarn needle

**Gauge:** 10 sts = 5"; Rows  
1-4 = 3" with 2 strands held  
together. **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge.



**RED HEART® Soft®**,

in solid color 5 oz  
(141 g), 256 yd (234 m), print  
4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m),  
and heather 4 oz (113 g), 212  
yd (194 m) balls



# Weekend Throw

Enjoying some time to relax on the weekend  
is easier with this cuddly crocheted  
throw. We've shown it in off white with a  
contrasting border, but it would be just as  
comforting in any color you desire.

**Throw measures 45" x 55".**

**Note:** Work with 2 strands held together  
throughout.

## Special Abbreviations

**shell** = 7 dc in next space.

**Vst** = (dc, ch 2, dc) all in st or space  
indicated.

## Throw

With **A**, ch 116.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in 2nd ch from  
hook and in next 5 ch, [ch 2, skip next  
3 ch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch, ch 2, skip  
next 3 ch, sc in next 5 ch] 9 times, sc in  
last ch; turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, skip first sc, dc in next 5 sc,  
[ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, Vst in next  
ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in next 5 sc] 9 times,  
dc in last sc; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next 5  
dc, [skip next ch-2 space, shell in next  
ch-2 space, skip next ch-2 space, dc in  
next 5 dc] 9 times, dc in top of ch-3;  
turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next  
5 dc, [ch 2, Vst in 4th dc of shell, ch 2,  
skip next 3 dc of shell, dc in next 5 dc] 9  
times, dc in top of ch-3; turn.

**Rows 5-62:** Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

**Row 63:** Ch 3, skip first dc, dc in next 5  
dc, [ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, (sc, ch  
2, sc) in next ch-2 space, skip next ch-2  
space, ch 2, dc in next 5 dc] 9 times, dc  
in top of ch-3; turn.

**Row 64:** Ch 1, sc in first 6 dc, [ch 3, skip  
next ch-2 space, sc in next ch-2 space,  
ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next 5  
dc] 9 times, sc in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

## Border

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join  
**B** in any corner; ch 1, [(sc, ch 2, sc) in  
corner, work an odd number of sc evenly  
spaced to keep work flat to next corner]  
4 times; join with a slip st in first sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, skip first sc, \* (sc, ch 2,  
sc, ch 3, sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner ch-2  
space, skip next sc, \*\* (sc, ch 2, sc) in  
next sc, skip next sc; repeat from \*\* to  
next corner; repeat from \* around; join.  
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B** = color A, B; **ch** = chain; **dc** =  
double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc**  
= single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); \*  
**or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \*  
as indicated; **[]** = work direction in  
brackets the number of times specified.



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
