



Contemporary Granny Ripple Throw

Using the same sort of easy stitch pattern as in a traditional granny square and striking black and grey color scheme, this throw has the “really cool” factor going for it. Crochet it as shown to please men and women alike, or change the colors to suit your personal style.

Throw is 42” x 53”.

Red Heart® “Super Saver” 3 skeins 932 Zebra **B**;
2 skeins each of 400 Grey Heather **A** and 313 Aran **C**;
1 skein 341 Light Grey **D**.

Crochet Hook: 6 mm [US J-10].

Yarn Needle

GAUGE: 21 sts (one pattern repeat from point to point) = 4¾”; 5 rows = 4”. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

reverse sc: *Insert hook in the next st to the right, yo, draw yarn through the st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.

THROW

With **A**, ch 165.

Row 1 (right side): 3 Dc in 6th ch from hook, skip next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch, skip next 2 ch, *(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch for point, [skip next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch] twice **, skip next 5 ch, [3 dc in next ch, skip next 2 ch] twice; repeat from * across to last 3 ch, ending last repeat at **; skip next 2 ch, dc in last ch; turn – 9 points.

Row 2: Ch 4, [3 dc between next two 3-dc groups] twice, *(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space, [3 dc between next two 3-dc groups] twice **, skip space between next 2 groups, [3 dc between next two 3-dc groups] twice; repeat from * across to last space, ending last repeat at **; skip last 3 dc, dc in last ch-space; turn.

Repeat Row 2 throughout, working in the following color sequence: 2 more rows **A**, *4 rows **B**, 4 rows **C**, 2 rows **D**, 4 rows **C**, 4 rows **B**, 4 rows **A**. Repeat from * twice – 67 rows. Fasten off.

Edging

Round 1: With right side facing, join **A** in any st; ch 1, work sc evenly around all 4 sides, taking care to keep work flat; join with a slip st to first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, working from left to right, reverse sc in each st around, join with slip st in first reverse sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **A, B, C, D** = color A, B, C, D; ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
