



Crochet Rich Treasure Throw

Designed by Glenda Winkleman.

Afghan measures approximately 41" x 61".

RED HEART® "Light and Lofty®": 3 Skeins 9334 Café Au Lait **CA**, 5 skeins 9376 Wine **CB**, 4 skeins 9617 Pheasant **CC**.

Crochet Hook: 11.5mm [US P-16].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: Rnds 1 and 2 = 3½" across. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.**

To change color in sc: Work last sc before color change until 2 loops remain on hook, drop color in use, with next

color to be used draw through 2 loops on hook. Continue with new color.

SQUARE (Make 54): With **CA**, ch 5; join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1A: Ch 3, 2 dc in ring, ch 2, [3 dc in ring, ch 2] 3 times; join with a sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Rnd 1B: Working between the 3-dc groups and over the ch-2 of the previous rnd, join **CB** in ring; ch 3, 2 dc in ring, ch 2, [3 dc in ring over the previous ch-2, ch 2] 3 times; join. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join **CC** in same st as joining; ch 3, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in next dc, * dc in next dc, working over the **CB** ch-2 of Rnd 1B dc in back lp of next 3 **CA** dc of Rnd 1A **, dc in next dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * around, end at **; join. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Changing colors as required, join **CB** in any corner ch-2 sp; ch 1, * (sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner ch-2 sp, with **CA**, sc in next dc, [with **CB**, sc in next dc, with **CA**, sc in next dc] 3 times; rep from * around; join with a sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING: With **CB**, sl st 6 x 9 Squares together in corresponding back lps of Rnd 3.

Border-Rnd 1: With right side facing, join **CB** in any sc; ch 1, sc evenly around and work (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner; join to first sc.

Rnds 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc around and work (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Art. E708, solids – 6oz (170g), 140 yd (128m), multis and stripes – 4.5 oz (127g), 105 yd (96m)
