



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

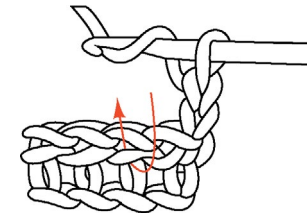
**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Hdchb** = Work 1 hdc into back horizontal bar created below in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram)



**Dc** = Double crochet

**Picot** = Ch 3. Sl st in 3rd ch from hook

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver® Ombre™** (10 oz/283 g; 482 yds/440 m)

True Blue (3962)

**5 balls**

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Yarn needle. 5 stitch markers.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 45" x 55" [114.5 x 138.5 cm].

## GAUGE

13 dc and 5 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Blanket is worked in a diagonal from corner to corner.

## THROW

Ch 6.

**1st row (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each of next 2 ch; turn – 1 cluster.

**2nd row (WS):** Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch (1 cluster made), (sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of previous row (1 cluster made); turn – 2 clusters.

**3rd row:** Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of previous row; rep from \* across; turn – 3 clusters.

**4th row:** Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of previous row; rep from \* across; turn, – 4 clusters.

Continue in this way, increasing one block on each row through 50th row – 50 clusters across.

Place a st marker in the corner to mark beginning of edging.

### Shaping Corners

**Note:** For 51st - 61st rows, you will create the rectangle shape by only increasing on one side of the throw. For 62nd - 110th rows, you will decrease one cluster in each row.

**51st row:** Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp of previous row; rep from \* across to last cluster, sl st in ch-3 sp of last cluster; turn – 50 clusters.

**52nd row:** Sl st across first 3 dc to ch-3 sp of previous row, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of previous row; rep from \* across; turn, – 50 clusters.

**53rd - 60th rows:** Rep 51st - 52nd rows.

**61st row:** Rep 51st row.

**62nd - 110th rows:** Sl st across first 3 dc to ch-3 sp of previous row, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of previous row; rep from \* across to last cluster; sl st in ch-3 sp of last cluster; turn.

Fasten off.

### Border

**Notes:** Work along top edge and one side edge only for Round 1. Place st marker in corners for all rounds, moving marker as you work.

**1st rnd:** Attach yarn with sl st to base of ch-3 at corner of 50th row where st marker was placed; \*ch 3, sl st in between next cluster\*\*; rep from \* to \*\* across top to corner, sl st in top of last dc of previous row cluster (50 ch-3 sps); rep from \* to \*\* along side, ending with ch 2, 1 hdc in top of dc from previous row (61 ch-3 sps) – 222 total ch-3 sps.

**2nd rnd:** (Ch 1, sc) in same sp, (ch 4, sc) in next ch-3 sp, [(ch 3, sc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to corner, (ch 4, sc) in next ch-3 sp] 4 times to last corner, ending with (ch 2, hdc) in beg sc – 218 ch-3 sps, four ch-4 corner sps.

**3rd rnd:** (Ch 1, sc) in same sp, (ch 3, sc) in next ch-3 sp, (ch 4, sc) in same sp, [\*ch 3, 1 sc in next ch-3 sp\*\*]; rep from \* to \*\* to corner, (ch 4, sc) in same sp] 4 times to last corner, ending with (ch 2, hdc) in beg sc – 222 ch-3 sps, four ch-4 corner sps.

**4th rnd:** (Ch 1, sc) in same sp, [(ch 3, sc) in next ch-3 sp] 2 times; (ch 4, sc) in same sp, [\*ch 3, 1 sc in next ch-3 sp\*\*]; rep from \* to \*\* to corner, (ch 4, sc) in same sp] 4 times to last corner, ending with ch 3, sl st to beg sc – 226 ch 3 sps, four ch-4 corner sps. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in all loose ends.
