



# Graphic Grannies Throw

**Finished Measurements: Approx 32½" x 39"**  
(82.5cm x 99cm)

**RED HEART® "Super Saver®":** 1 skein each 579 Pale Plum **A**, 358 Lavender **B**, 316 Soft White **C**, 312 Black **D** and 774 Lt. Raspberry **E**

**Crochet Hook:** Size H/8 (5mm)  
Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Rounds 1–3 of basic granny square = 3½ x 3½" (9 x 9cm) square using H/8 (5mm) crochet hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the specified gauge.**

## NOTES

**1** Each round of a granny square may begin with a new color. To change color between rounds, fasten off the old color at the end of a round and join the new color in any corner ch-sp to begin the next round.

**2** If no color change is made, sl st across sts to reach the first ch-2 sp to begin the next round.

**3** When joining a new color, hold the right side of the granny square facing you.

## GRANNY SQUARE

(Make 30 – 6 with **A**, 8 with **B**, 7 with **C**, 5 with **D**, and 4 with **E**)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, [ch 2, 3 dc in ring] 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beginning ch – 12 dc, 4 ch-2 sp. If a color change is to be made, fasten off.

**Round 2:** Sl st in each st into first ch-2 sp or join new color with sl st in any ch-2 sp; ch 3, [2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in same ch-2 sp (corner made), \*ch 1, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in next ch-2 sp (corner made);

repeat from \* 2 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beginning ch – 4 corners, 4 ch-1 sp. If a color change is to be made, fasten off.

**Round 3:** Sl st in each st into first ch-2 sp or join new color with sl st in any ch-2 sp; ch 3, [2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in next ch-2 sp; repeat from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beginning ch – 4 corners, 8 ch-1 sp, 3 dc along each side.

If a color change is to be made, fasten off.

**Round 4:** Sl st in each st into first ch-2 sp or join new color with sl st in any ch-2 sp; ch 3, [2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in same ch-2 sp, \*[ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] across to next ch-2 sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in next ch-2 sp; repeat from \* 2 more times, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] across to next ch-2 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beginning ch – 4 corners, 12 ch-1 sp, 6 dc along each side.

If a color change is to be made, fasten off.

**Rounds 5-6:** Repeat Round 4.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends on all granny squares. Join pieces as follows:

Hold wrong sides of 2 squares together. Working in back loops of stitches of both pieces, join desired color with sc in 2nd ch of a corner ch-2 sp of front square, sc in each st across edge of pieces, ending with sc in first ch of next corner ch-2 sp of front square.



Refer to photo for color placement. Starting at center of throw, join one **D** and one **E** square together with **D**. Join two **A** squares together with **A**, then join both sets of joined squares together with **A**. Continue to join squares together in same manner, working from center of throw outward, piecing same-color squares into long strips and joining whole strips to center in one seam using same color yarn as strip joining. Add strips in this order: 2 squares of **C**, 3 squares of **B**, 3 squares of **E**, 4 squares of **D**, 4 squares of **A**, 5 squares of **C** and 5 squares of **B**. Weave in all ends.
