



## Crochet Cable Squares Blanket

*Designed by Anne Halliday.*

**Afghan measures approximately 118 cm x 155 cm (47" x 62").**

**RED HEART® “Comfort®”, Art. E707D (45 oz)**  
3 balls No. 3191 Mocha or 4 balls of multi shade.

**Crochet Hook:** 5.5mm [US I-9].  
Yarn needle.

**TENSION:** Square = 7½". **CHECK YOUR TENSION.**  
Use any size hook to obtain the tension.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

**Front Post Treble Crochet (fptr):** [yo] twice, insert hook from front to back to front around post of st indicated, yo and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 lps] 3 times.

**Cable (uses next 4 sts):** Skip next 2 sts, fptr around next 2 sts; working in front of fptr just made, fptr around first skipped st, then around next skipped st. Skip 4 sts behind cable.

**Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc):** yo, insert hook from front to back to front around post of st indicated, yo and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 lps] twice. Skip st behind fpdc.

**DEC:** [Draw up a lp in next st] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**SQUARE (Make 48)-Rnd 1 (Right Side):** Ch 4; dc in 4th ch from hook, ch 3, [2 dc, ch 3] 3 times all in same ch; join with a sl st to top of beg ch.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in next dc; (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) all in next ch-3 sp – corner made; \* dc in next 2 dc, corner in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around; join to top of ch-3.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in next 3 dc, ch 3, corner in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, work Cable over next 4 sts, \* dc in next dc, corner in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, work Cable over next 4 sts; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 4, \* skip next dc, dc in next dc, corner in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, fpdc around next 4 fptr \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 4, \* skip next st, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, corner in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] twice, work Cable over next 4 sts \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 4, \* dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] twice, corner in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] 3 times, fpdc



around next 4 fptr \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 4, \* dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] 3 times, corner in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc] 4 times, work Cable over next 4 sts \*\*, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

**FINISHING:** Sew 8 squares together into 6 vertical strips, then sew strips together.

**Border-Rnd 1:** With right side facing, join yarn in any corner ch-3 sp; \*\* ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner sp, \* ch 1, sc in next dc, ch 1, skip next st, [sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 5 times, DEC, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 6 times, [ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 1, skip seam, sc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 6 times, DEC, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 6 times; rep from \* to next corner; rep from \*\* around; ch 1; join with a sl st to first sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*\* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner ch-2 sp, sc in next sc, \* ch 1, sc in next sc; rep from \* to next corner; rep from \*\* around; ch 1; join.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, skip next sc, \*\* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, skip next sc, \* sc in next sc, ch 1, skip next st; rep from \* to next corner; rep from \*\* around; join.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sl st in next sp, ch 1, \*\* (sl st, ch 2, sl st) all in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, \* sl st in next sp, ch 1; rep from \* to next corner; rep from \*\* around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.



**RED HEART® “Comfort®”,** Art. E707D available in 454g (16 oz), 850 m (930 yds) solid balls or 340g (12 oz), 625 m (683 yds) multicolour balls.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **beg** = beginning; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **dec** = decrease; **lp(s)** = loop(s); **mm** = millimeters; **pat** = pattern; **rep** = repeat; **rnd** = round; **sc** = single crochet; **sl** = slip; **sp(s)** = space(s); **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tr** = treble crochet; **yo** = yarn over; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
