### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Gemstone:**  
3 balls each 2354 Lemon Jade  
A and 2136 Diamond B

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
6 mm [US J-10].

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 1 ripple = 4¾" (12 cm)  
from peak to peak; 12 dc = 4"  
(10 cm); 7 rows = 5½" (14 cm).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use  
any size hook to obtain the  
gauge.

# Ripples in the Pond Throw

Believe it or not, this easy throw uses only two colors of yarn! By alternating two rows each of two Gemstone yarn colors, you create a throw that has a fresh new look to blend with your décor.

**Throw measures 44" wide x 55" long**  
(112 x 139.5 cm).

### Special Stitch

**dc2tog** = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### Notes

1. Throw is made in a ripple pattern which consists of a series of two 2-dc "peaks" and 2 dc2tog "valleys", with 5 dc worked between peaks and valleys. You may need to work several rows before the ripple is clearly visible.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Do not cut color not in use; carry along wrong side of piece until next needed.

### THROW

With **A**, ch 147 loosely.

**Row 1 (right side):** Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning 3 skipped ch count as first dc), dc in next 5 ch, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 ch, \*2 dc in next 2 ch, dc in next 5 ch, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 ch; repeat from \* across to last ch, 2 dc in last ch, turn—144 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in first dc; working in back loops only, dc in next 5 dc, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 dc, \*2 dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 dc; repeat from \* across to beginning ch, working in both loops, 2 dc in top of beginning ch; change to **B**, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until throw measures 55" (139.5 cm) long, changing color at end of every other row. Fasten off.



### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B** = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
