



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 47½" x 58" [120.5 x 147.5 cm], excluding pompoms.

GAUGE

12 dc and 7.5 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

BLANKET

Notes:

- Blanket is worked in rows from Bottom Edge, around top, and back down to Bottom Edge.
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through rem loops and proceed with new color.

- Markers are placed between sts. Move markers up as you work each row - 100 sts from markers to ends of rows.

Stripe Pat

A - 4 rows; B - 8 rows; C - 8 rows; D - 8 rows; E - 8 rows; F - 8 rows.

These 44 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, ch 103.

1st row: Set-up: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to last ch. PM between last dc and next st made. 7 dc in last ch. **Do not** turn. Cont working down other side of foundation ch as follows: PM between last dc and next st made. 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 207 dc.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Contrast A Soft Navy (0387) **1 ball**

Contrast B Royal (0385) **1 ball**

Contrast C Hunter Green (0389) **1 ball**

Contrast D Bright Yellow (0324) **1 ball**

Contrast E Petal Pink (0373) **2 balls**

Contrast F Cherry Red (0319) **2 balls**

Contrast G Soft White (0316) **2 balls**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
2 stitch markers.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc here and throughout). 1 dc in each dc to marker. 2 dc in each of next 3 dc. 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in each of next 3 dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 213 dc.

3rd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to marker. (2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 1 dc in next dc. (1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next dc) 3 times. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 219 dc.

4th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to marker. (2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc.) 3 times. 1 dc in next dc. (1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc) 3 times. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Join B. Break A. Turn. 225 dc.

5th row: With B, ch 3. 1 dcbl in each dc to marker. (2 dcbl in next dc. 1 dcbl in each of next 3 dc.) 3 times. 1 dcbl in next dc. (1 dcbl in each of next 3 dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) 3 times. 1 dcbl in each dc to end of row. Turn. 231 dc.

6th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each st to marker. (2 dc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 4 sts.) 3 times. 1 dc in next st. (1 dc in each of next 4 sts. 2 dc in next st) 3 times. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn. 237 dc.

First 6 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, **AT SAME TIME** inc 6 sts each row as established, working in back loops only in every first row after each color change (13th, 21st, 29th, and 29th rows only) until 44 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. 465 dc. Join G. Break F.

45th row: (RS). With G, ch 1. 1 sc in each st across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Surface Crochet: (RS). Join G with sl st to first rem loop from 5th row. Ch 1. 1 sc in each rem loop across 5th row to create ridge detail separating colored stripes. Rep for each first row after color change.

Bottom Edging: 1st row: (RS). Join G with sl st at corner to work along Bottom Edge of Blanket. Ch 3. Work dc evenly across. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc across. Fasten off.

Pompoms (make 12): With G, wind yarn around 3 fingers approx 100 times. Tie yarn tightly in the middle and leave long ends for attaching to Blanket. Cut loops at both ends and trim to smooth round shape. Sew Pompoms evenly spaced across Bottom Edge of Blanket (as shown in photo).
