Size U.S. I/9 ( 5.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\oplus}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ steel yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46" x 62" [117 x 157.5 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

13 dc and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as st.

Ch 151. See diagram on page 3.
1st row: 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 149 sts.
2nd row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 10 sts. ${ }^{*}$ Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 15 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 10 sts. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 9 sts. *Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 13 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 9 sts. Turn.
4th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 8 sts. ${ }^{*}$ Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 11 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 8 sts. Turn.
5th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 7 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 9 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 7 sts. Turn.

6th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 6 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 5 sts. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 6 sts. Turn.
7th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 5 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
8th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 4 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 9 sts. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in last st. Turn. 9th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 3 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 11 sts. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dc in each of last 2 sts. Turn. 10th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 3 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 13 sts. Ch 1 . Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dc in each of last 2 sts. Turn.

11th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 3 sts. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 11 sts. Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in last st. Turn.
12th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 4 sts. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 9 sts. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in last st. Turn.
13th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 5 sts. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 5 dc . Rep from * to end of row.
14th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 6 sts. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 5 sts. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 6 sts. Turn.

15th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 7 sts . *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. Ch 1 . Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 9 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 7 sts. Turn.
16th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 8 sts. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next st. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 11 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 8 sts. Turn. 17th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 9 sts. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 13 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 9 sts . Turn. 18th row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 10 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 15 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending last rep with 1 dc in each of last 10 sts. Turn.

Rep 3rd to 18th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 60 " $[152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a 17th row.

Next row: Ch 2.1 dc in each of first 10 sts. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 15 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 1 dc in each of last 10 sts. Do not fasten off. Do not turn.

Edging rnd: *3 sc in corner. Work in sc evenly down length of Blanket. 3 sc in corner. Work in sc evenly along width of Blanket. Rep from * once more. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Cut strands of yarn 24" [61 cm] long. With RS facing and taking 6 strands tog fold in half and knot into fringe approx every $21 / 2$ " [ 6.5 cm ] evenly across bottom edge, including 1 fringe at each corner of Blanket, noting each knotted section has 12 strands.

## 'arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

1st Knotted Row: Divide each knotted section into 2 groups of 6 strands. Skip first group. **Taking left-most group from next knotted section and right-most group from previous knotted section, wrap 1 strand of yarn around these 12 strands 6 times $11 / 2$ " $[4 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] down from each knot so that wrapped yarn is centered. Knot to fasten securely.


Cont in this manner, taking left-most group of strands from next knotted section and right-most group of strands from prev knotted section, wrapping and knotting to secure **, noting first and last 6-strand groups are not wrapped.

2nd Knotted Row: Divide each knotted section into 2 groups of 6 strands. Taking first skipped group from 1st Knotted Row, and left-most group of strands from next knotted section, wrap 1 strand of yarn around these 12 strands 6 times 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ down from first knot. Knot to fasten securely. Rep from ** to ** from 1st Knotted Row across to last 2 groups. Taking final skipped group from 1st Knotted Row and right-most group from prev knotted section, wrap 1 strand of yarn around these 12 strands 6 times 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] down from last knot. Knot to fasten securely. Trim ends of fringe evenly.

Rep across top edge of Blanket.
