MATERIALS

Red Heart® With Love™ (7 oz/x 198; 370 yds/338 m)

Contrast A Black (1012)

4 balls

Contrast B Egghell(1101)

4 balls

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip Stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 44 x 60" [112 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

12 sts and 10 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in Griddle St Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

· When changing yarn colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in new color, leaving old color at WS of work

· Carry color when not in use across top of previous row and work sts around it to avoid stranding. Give yarn a gentle tug to ensure carried yarn sits flat against top of row.

With B, ch 141.

Beg working Chart in Griddle St Pat indicated below, *reading RS* rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right, noting first 20-st block is worked once, and 40st repeat is worked 3 times.

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Each square represents one st in Griddle St Pat.

Griddle St Pat

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: (WS). Ch 1. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.


Rep 2nd row for Griddle St Pat until 36-row Chart has been worked a total of 4 times. Finished blanket is 8 blocks tall by 7 blocks wide.

Turn at the end of last row. Break B. **Do not** fasten off A.

Border:

1st round: (RS). With B, ch 1. Work 1 sc in each st across top of Blanket to last st. Work 3 sc in last st. Work in sc down side of blanket, working 1 sc in side of each sc, and 2 sc in side of each dc. Work around rest of Blanket as established, working 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st sto first sc.

2nd round: Ch 1. Work 1 sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
