

CRED HEART SIMPLE PLAID CROCHET BLANKET

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Main Color (MC) Light Sage (0631) 7 balls

Contrast A Frosty Green (0661) 2 balls

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =

Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Hdc = Half double

crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep(s) = Repeat(s)

Sp(s) = Space(s)

Splhdc = Split half double crochet: work hdc between 'legs' at front and back of stitch (splitting stitch) instead of through top loops. Stitches should appear as "V"s on RS and WS of

work.

Surface SI st =

Holding working yarn at back of work, insert hook in first ch-1 space. Draw up a loop. Insert hook into next ch-1 space. Yoh and pull loop through to front of work and onto hook. Draw loop through loop on hook.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46½" x 56½" [118 x 143.5 cml.

GAUGE

11 sts and 12 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

BLANKET

With MC, ch 130.

Set-up row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (skipped ch-2 does not count as st) 1 hdc in each of next 9 ch. *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 hdc in each of next 2 ch. Ch 1. Skip next ch.** 1 hdc in each of next 22 hdc. Rep from * to last 14 ch. Rep from * to ** once more. 1 hdc in each of last 10 ch. Turn. (118 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps).

1st row: Ch 1. 1 splhdc in each of first 10 sts. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 splhdc in each of next 2 sts. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp.** 1 splhdc in each of next 22 sts. Rep from * to last 14 sts. Rep from * to ** once more. 1 splhdc in each of last 10 sts. Turn.

Rep last row 12 times more. ***Join A on last row.

With A, rep 1st row twice. Join MC. With MC, rep 1st row twice. Join A. With A, rep 1st row twice. Break A. Join MC.****

With MC, rep 1st row 28 times.***
Rep from *** to *** 3 more times,
then from *** to **** once.
With MC, rep 1st row 14 times.
(170 rows in total have been
worked.)
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Vertical Surface SI St Rows: With A, working from bottom of Blanket to top edge, surface sI st in each ch-1 sp of every row. Fasten off. Rep across width of Blanket.
