## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Bobble** = (Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times in indicated st. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Rem** = Remain(s)(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**Tr** = Treble crochet

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver Jumbo™** (Solids: 14 oz/396 g; 744 yds/681 m  
Multis: 10 oz/283 g; 482 yds/440 m)

**Contrast A** Retro Stripes (4971)

**2 balls**

**Contrast B** White (0311)

**1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 [5 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

**Motif:** 12" [30.5 cm] square.

**Blanket:** Approx 36" [91.5 cm] square.

## GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Ch 4 at beg of round counts as (1 dc. Ch 1)
- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as (1 hdc. Ch 1)
- Ch 2 at beg of rnd **does not** count as st.

**Flower Square:** Make 9 Squares.  
See *Diagram on page 3*.  
With A, begin using magic ring method, demonstrated [here](#).

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 6 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 4. 1 dc in first st. \*(1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next st. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of starting ch-4. Fasten off A.

**3rd rnd:** Join B with sl st to any ch-1 sp. Ch 3. 1 hdc in same sp as sl st. Ch 2. \*(1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc) in next ch-1 sp. Ch 2. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to 2nd ch of starting ch-2.

**4th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-1 sp. \*Ch 4. Sl st in same sp as sl st. Ch 6. Sl st in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of starting ch-4.

**5th rnd:** Sl st to next ch-4 sp. \*(Ch 2. 1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 2. Sl st) all in same ch-4 sp. Ch 2. Sl st in center of next ch-6 sp. Ch 2. Sl st in next ch-4 sp. Rep from \* around, joining rnd with sl st to first ch-4 sp.

**6th rnd:** Sl to to next ch-1 sp (top of flower). Ch 1. 3 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. \*3 sc in next ch-1 sp. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off B.

**7th rnd:** Join A with sl st to first sc. Ch 2. \*1 dc in each of next 3 sc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 extended tr between next 2 dc in 2nd rnd pulling loop to the height of 7th rnd. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first dc. 48 sts.

**8th rnd:** Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) in next dc – corner made. [1 dc in each of next 11 dc. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) all in next dc] 3 times. 1 dc in last st. Join with sl st to first dc.

**9th to 13th rnds:** Ch 3. [1 dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) in ch-2 sp] 4 times. 1 dc in each dc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first dc. Fasten off.

## Motif Borders and Joining Squares

### Motif Border

Join B with sl st to any corner ch-2 sp.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. \*(1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each st to next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

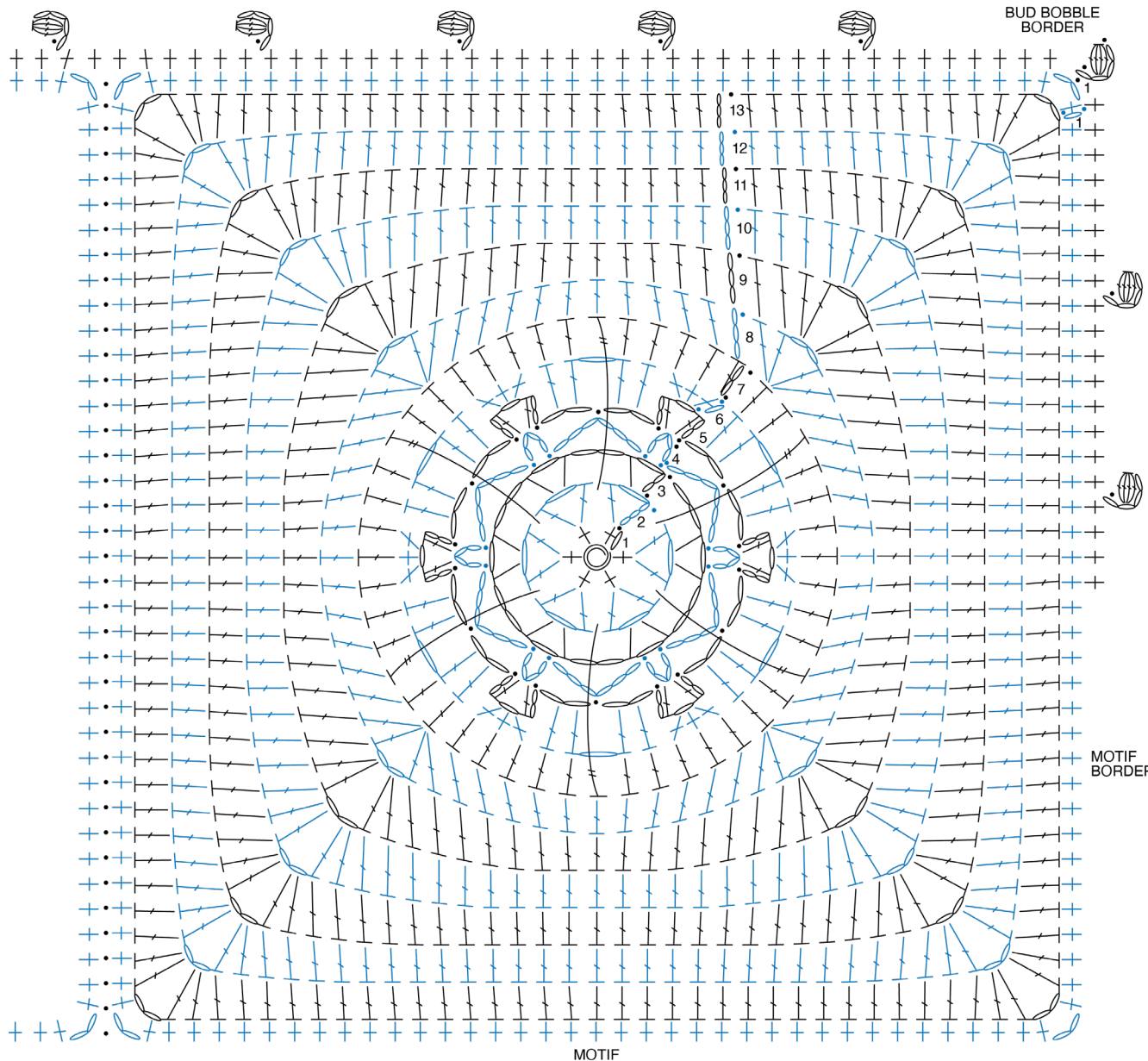
Lie Squares out in a 3 x 3 grid. Using a [slip stitch join](#), first join all Squares vertically, and then horizontally.








### Snowball Bobble Border

Join A with sl st to any corner ch-2 sp of assembled Blanket.

**1st rnd:** \*Ch 4. Bobble in 3rd ch from hook. Sl st in rem ch of ch-4. 1 sc in each of next 8 sts. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first Bobble. Fasten off.
