CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Main Color (MC) Soft White (0316) **2 balls or 695 yds/635 m**

Contrast A Light Periwinkle (0347) **1 ball or 262 yds/240 m**

Contrast B Lavender (0358) **1 ball or 262 yds/240 m**

Contrast C Cherry Red (0319) **1 ball or 262 yds/240 m**

Red Heart® Bitty Stripes™ (10 oz/283 g; 515 yds/471 m)

Contrast D Lollies (0112) **1 ball or 367 yds/335 m**

Contrast E Grapey (0114) **1 ball or 367 yds/335 m**

Contrast F Love Bug (0106) **1 ball or 367 yds/335 m**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook
or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle.
Susan Bates® stitch markers.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

12 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

Stripe Pat 1:

Work 26 rows in Color 1
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 40 rows in Color 2
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 26 rows in Color 3
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 40 rows in Color 4
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 26 rows in Color 5
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 40 rows in Color 6
 These 218 rows form Stripe Pat 1.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Blanket is constructed in Panels and then seamed.

WIDE PANEL (Make 3 total - one each in Panel 1, Panel 2, and Panel 3).

	Panel 1	Panel 2	Panel 3
Color 1	B	C	A
Color 2	D	F	E
Color 3	A	B	C
Color 4	E	D	F
Color 5	C	A	B
Color 6	F	E	D

With Color 1, ch 31.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 30 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat 1 are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 1, rep 2nd row until all 218 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Fasten off.

Wide Panel Edging

With RS facing, join MC with sl st in top right corner of Wide Panel.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. PM in first sc worked. 1 sc in each of next 28 sc. 3 sc in next sc. PM in center sc of 3 sc. Work 174 sc evenly down side edge of Panel. *Working in rem loops of foundation ch*, 3 sc in next ch. PM in center sc of 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 28 ch. 3 sc in next ch. PM in center sc of 3 sc. Work 174 sc evenly up side edge of Panel. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Join. 416 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. PM in first sc worked. *1 sc in each sc to next marked sc. 3 sc in marked st. Move marker to center sc of 3 sc. Rep from * twice more. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. 1 sc in same sp as first sc. Join. 424 sc. Fasten off.

THIN PANEL (Make 2 total – one each in Panel 4 and Panel 5).

Stripe Pat 2:

Work 33 rows in Color 1
 Work 1 row in MC
 Work 10 rows on Color 1.
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 22 rows in Color 2
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 33 rows in Color 3
 Work 1 row in MC
 Work 10 rows in Color 3
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 22 rows in Color 4
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 33 rows in Color 5
 Work 1 row in MC
 Work 10 rows in Color 5
 Work 4 rows in MC
 Work 22 rows in Color 6
 These 218 rows form Stripe Pat 2.

With Color 1, ch 22.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 12 ch. Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in each of last 7 ch. Turn. 20 sc and ch-1 sp.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat 2 are complete.

Note: It is helpful to PM on ch-1 sp while working sections of Red Heart Bitty Stripes shades in Stripe Pat 2.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 2nd row until first 44 rows of Stripe Pat 2 are complete.

Cont as follows:

45th row: With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to ch-1 sp. 1 sc in ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 21 sc.

46th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 2, rep 46th row until first 74 rows of Stripe Pat 2 are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 2, proceed as follows:

75th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 13 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

76th to 118th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

119th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

120th to 148th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

149th row: As 75th row.

150th to 192nd rows: As 76th row.

193rd row: As 119th row.

194th to 218th rows: As 120th row.

Fasten off.

Surface Chain sts: 1st vertical row: With RS of Thin Panel facing, join MC with sl st to first ch-1 sp of foundation row. Pull loop to maintain length of first row. Working vertically, insert hook in corresponding ch-1 sp of next row. Yoh and draw up a loop – first ch made. Work in chains up first 44 rows of Thin Panel. Fasten off.

Rep for rem vertical rows of ch-1 sps up Thin Panel.

Thin Panel Edging

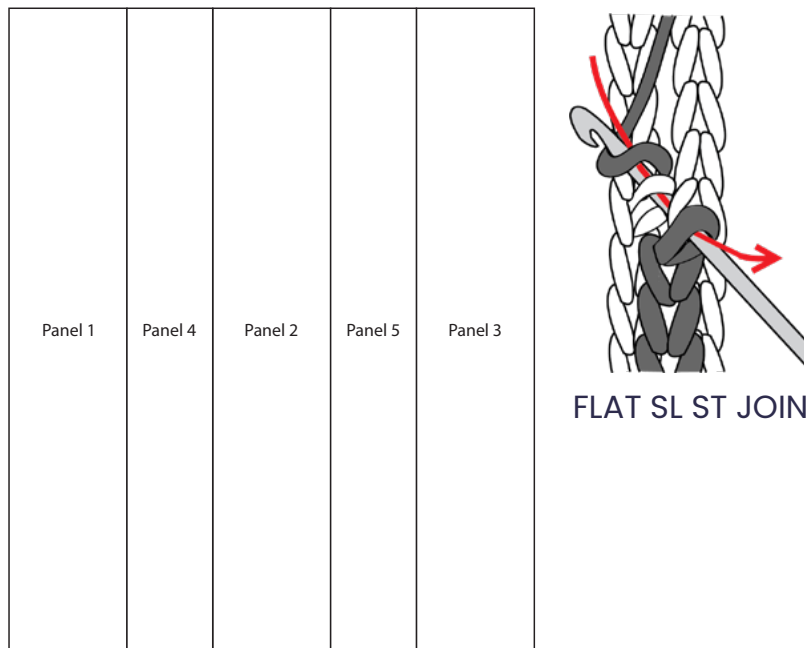
With RS facing, join MC with sl st in top right corner of Thin Panel.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. PM in first sc worked. 1 sc in each of next 19 sc. 3 sc in next sc. PM in center sc of 3 sc. Work 174 sc evenly down side edge of Panel. *Working in rem loops of foundation ch*, 3 sc in next ch. PM in center sc of 3 sc. 1 sc in each of next 19 ch. 3 sc in next ch. PM in center sc of 3 sc. Work 174 sc evenly up side edge of Panel. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Join. 398 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. PM in first sc worked. *1 sc in each sc to next marked sc. 3 sc in marked st. Move marker to center sc of 3 sc. Rep from * twice more. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. 1 sc in same sp as first. Join. 406 sc. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Seaming with Flat Sl St Join: (RS). With MC and following assembly diagram below, sl st Panels tog, working through back loops only and keeping working yarn to WS of work to create a flat sl st chain detail on RS of work (see diagram).



Note: Keep working yarn to WS of work so only flat sl st chain is visible on RS.

BORDER

With RS facing, join MC with sl st to marked st at top right corner of Blanket (top right corner of Panel 3).

1st rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. PM in first sc worked. *1 sc in each st to next marked st. Sc2tog over next 2 marked sts.** Rep from * 3 times more. (1 sc in each st to next marked st. 3 sc in next sc. PM in center sc of 3 sc) twice. Rep from * to ** 4 times more. 1 sc in each st to next marked st. 3 sc in next sc. PM in center sc of 3 sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Join with sl st to first sc. 660 sts.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first st. PM in first sc worked. *1 sc in each st to next marked st. 3 sc in marked st. Rep from * twice more. 1 sc in each st to end of rnd. 1 sc in same sp as first sc. Join with sl st to first sc. 668 sc.

Fasten off.

BOWS

Thin Bow (Make 6 alike).

With MC, ch 25.

1st row: Working into 'bump' at back of ch, 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sl st in each ch to end of chain. Fasten off.

Wide Bow (Make 9 total – 3 each in A, B, and C).

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

Ch 14.

1st row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 2 ch. 1 sc in each of next 6 ch. 1 hdc in each of last 3 ch. Turn. 6 sc and 6 hdc.

2nd to 5th rows: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first 3 hdc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. 1 hdc in each of last 3 hdc. Turn.
Fasten off at end of last row.

Center Band:

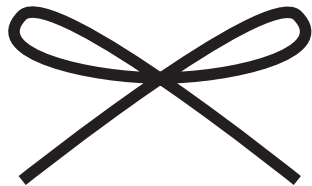
Ch 6.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 5 sc.

2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Fasten off at end of last row, leaving long tail for sewing.
Turn Center Band so rows run vertically. Fold Center Band around middle of Wide Bow, pinching Wide Bow to fit. With long tail and yarn needle, sew both ends of Center Band tog to secure. **Do not** break long tails.

FINISHING

Fold Thin Bows as shown in diagram below. With MC, sew Thin Bows to Panels 4 and 5 where Surface Chain Detail crosses single row of MC, working around Thin Bow where it overlaps to form 'knot'.



With yarn needle and rem long tails, sew Wide Bows to Panels 1, 2, and 3, as shown.
