What you will need:

RED HEART* Super Saver*: 1 skein each 316 Soft White A and 312 Black B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6]

Small amount of fiberfill, stitch markers, yarn needle


GAUGE: 17 sc = 4" [10 cm]; 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Spooky Ghost Jar Cozy

Set the stage for Halloween fun with this ghoulish jar cozy! It's easily crocheted and then given personality with simple embroidery stitches.

Cozy to fit quart size Mason jar

COZY

Beginning at top of head, ch 37 with **A**. **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 36 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, [sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times - 42 sc.

Rows 3-21: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 22: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in next 5 sc, 2 dc in next sc, [dc in next 6 sc, 2 dc in next sc] 5 times – 48 dc.

Row 23: Ch 1, turn, [sc in next st, skip next st, 5 dc next st, sk next st] 11 times, sc in next st skip next st, 5 dc in next st, sc in last st. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew side seams together for back seam.

ARM (make 2)

Note: Arm is worked in continuous rounds.

With A, ch 2.

Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Rounds 3-5: Sc in each sc around. **Round 6:** (Sc in next sc, ch 3, work 4

dc in same sc, remove hook and put it through top of ch-3, draw loop of last dc through) all in same st for thumb, sc in remaining 11 sc.

Round 7: Skip thumb, sc in next 11 sc. Rounds 8-11: Sc in each sc around. Fasten off, leaving long end for sewing. Stuff hand section. do not stuff arm.

FINISHING

Flatten last round of each arm and sew one arm on either side of Cozy.

Embroidery

Note: It may be easier to work embroidery while Cozy is on the jar. Refer to photo for placements.

Use a double strand of **B** and satin stitch to embroider mouth. Use satin stitch to embroider two eyes.

Weave in ends.
