Spooky Pumpkin Jar Cozy

Add a happy face to your Halloween décor with this colorful jar cozy! It's easily crocheted and then given individuality with simple embroidery for his face.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 3251 Flame **A** and 312 Black **B**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sc = 4" [10 cm]; 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

SHOP KIT

Cover to fit quart size Mason jar

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sc2tog: [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

COVER

Working sideways, ch 25 with **A**.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 24 sc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 6 (Right Side): Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, [sc in next sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc] 8 times – 16 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 8 times – 24 sc.

Rows 8-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 12: Repeat Row 6.

Row 13: Repeat Row 7.

Rows 14-55: Repeat Rows 8-13. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew side seams together for back seam.

FINISHING

With right side facing, join **A** with a slip st in seam at lower edge, working along side edges of rows, [sc in next 4 rows, sc2tog over next 2 rows] across. Fasten off.

Embroidery

Note: It may be easier to work embroidery while Cover is on the jar. Refer to photo for placements.

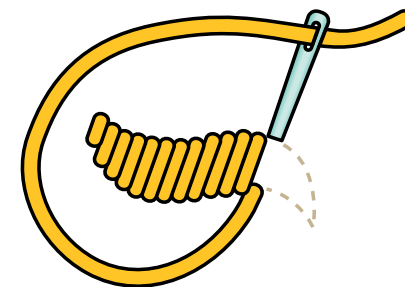
Use a double strand of **B** and work horizontal satin stitches to embroider mouth. Add smile lines with straight stitches. Use horizontal satin stitches to embroider eyebrows and nose. Work vertical satin stitches to embroider eyes. Work a line of backstitches around each eye.



Use **A** and satin stitch to embroider tooth on mouth
Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
