What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft Baby Steps®: 1 ball each 9505 Aqua **A** and 9590 Lavender **B**

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each 4601 Off White **C** and 4614 Black **D**

Note: Only small amounts of each color are needed for this project.

GAUGE: With 6.0mm [J-10] hook, 16 sc = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge given.

Doggie Doorknob Cozy

Crochet a happy little doggie to greet little ones! Choose any favorite color or coordinate with the room décor.

What you will need: (continued)

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 6.0mm [US J-10], 5.0mm [US H-8], 3.5mm [US E-4], 2.75mm [US C-2]

Yarn needle

Cozy fits doorknobs 6¼" (16 cm) around.

Special Stitches

sc2tog = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Note

Unless otherwise noted, Rounds are worked without joining or turning.

COZY

Head

With 6.0mm [J-10] hook and **A**, ch 2.

Round 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook—6 sc.

Round 2: [2 sc in sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc] twice—10 sc.

Round 3: Sc, 2 sc in next sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 2 sc—12 sc.

Round 4: Sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 5: Working in front loops only, [sc, 2 sc in next sc, 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] twice, sc, 2 sc in next sc—17 sc.

Round 6: Working in both loops, 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, [3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times, 2 sc—21 sc.

Round 7: [6 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times—24 sc.

Round 8: 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 12 sc—25 sc.

Round 9: Sc in each sc around—25 sc.

Round 10: 12 sc, sc2tog, 11 sc; ch 1, turn—24 sc.

Round 11: [6 sc, sc2tog] 3 times; ch 1, turn—21 sc.

Round 12: [3 sc, sc2tog] 4 times, sc; ch 1, turn—17 sc.

Round 13: [Sc, sc2tog] 5 times, 2 sc—12 sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Nose

With 2.75mm [C-2] hook and **D**, ch 3.

Row 1: Work (dc, hdc, sc, dc, sc, hdc, dc) all in 3rd ch from hook, ch 2, slip st into same st as last dc—8 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Spot

With 3.5mm [E-4] hook and **B**, ch 3.

Round 1: Work (6 hdc, 6 dc) In 3rd ch from hook; slip st in first st to join—12 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Eye (Make 2)

With 3.5mm [E-4] hook and **C**, ch 2.

Round 1: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook; slip st in first st to join—5 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Pupil (Make 2)

With 2.75mm [C-2] hook and **D**, ch 2.

Round 1: 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook; slip st into same st as last sc—2 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Ear (Make 2)

Make one Ear with **A** and one with **B**. With 5.0mm [H-8] hook, ch 2.

Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc.

Round 2: [2 sc in next sc, 2 sc] twice—8 sc.

Round 3: [2 sc in next sc, 3 sc] twice—10 sc.

Round 4: Sc in each sc around—10 sc.

Round 5: Sc2tog, 8 sc—9 sc.

Round 6: Sc in each sc around—9 sc.

Round 7: Sc2tog, 7 sc—8 sc.

Round 8: Sc2tog, 6 sc—7 sc.

Round 9: Sc2tog, 5 sc—6 sc.

Round 10: Sc in each sc around—6 sc.

Round 11: Sc2tog; pinch the opening closed.

Continued...

SHOP KIT



Hold the next stitch and the stitch across from it together; working through both stitches at once, sc the stitches together. Sc the two end stitches together in the same way—3 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Finishing

Referring to photograph for placement, sew Nose to snout in center of Cozy. Embroider a mouth on snout below the Nose. Sew Pupils to Eyes. Sew one Eye to Spot, then sew Spot to Cozy above the snout. Sew other Eye above the snout. Sew Ears above Eyes. Weave in all ends.
