# What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball each 4601 Off White A and 4614 Black B Note: One ball of each will make several

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 6.0mm [US J-10], 3.5mm [US

Stitch markers, yarn needle

E-4], 2.75mm [US C-2]

GAUGE: With 6.0mm [J-10] hook, 16 sc = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm]. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge given.

# SHOP KIT



# Panda Doorknob Cozy

Crochet this cute panda to happily greet a child entering the bedroom or playroom. It can be crocheted quickly with easy-care yarn.

Cozy fits doorknobs 61/4" (16 cm) around.

#### **Special Stitches**

**sc2tog** = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

#### Note

Unless otherwise noted, Rounds are worked without joining or turning. It may be helpful to use stitch markers to mark ends of Rounds.

### COZY

#### Head

With 6.0mm [J-10] hook and A, ch 2.

Round 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook—6 sc.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 3: 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc—15 sc.

**Round 4:** 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 4 sc—17 sc.

Round 5: Sc in each sc around—17 sc.

**Round 6:** Working in front loops only, 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, [3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times, 2 sc—21 sc.

**Round 7:** Working in both loops, [6 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times—24 sc.

Round 8: 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 12 sc—25 sc.

Round 9: Sc in each sc around—25 sc.

**Round 10:** 12 sc, sc2tog, 11 sc; ch 1, turn—24 sc.

**Round 11:** [6 sc, sc2tog] 3 times; ch 1, turn—21 sc.

**Round 12:** [3 sc, sc2tog] 4 times, sc; ch 1, turn—17 sc.

**Round 13:** [Sc, sc2tog] 5 times, 2 sc—12 sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

#### Nose

With 2.75mm [C-2] hook and **B**, ch 3.

Row 1: Work (dc, hdc, sc, dc, sc, hdc, dc) all in 3rd ch from hook, ch 2, slip st into same st as last dc—8 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

## Eye (Make 2)

With 2.75mm [C-2] hook and **B**, ch 4.

**Row 1:** 2 sc in second ch from hook, slip st in next ch. 3 sc in last ch—6 sts.

Row 2: Turn and work into the opposite side of the foundation chain. 3 sc in first ch, slip st in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; slip st in top of first sc in Row 1 to join—7 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

# Ear (Make 2)

With 3.5mm [E-4] hook and **B**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook; ch 1, turn—4 sc.

Round 2: [2 sc in next sc] 4 times; ch 1, turn—8 sc.

**Round 3:** 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc—9 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

# **Finishing**

Referring to photograph for placement, sew Nose to snout in center of Cozy. Embroider a mouth on snout below the Nose. Sew Eyes above snout. Sew Ears above Eyes. Weave in all ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B = Color A, Color B; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
