## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** Cozy 1: 1 skein each 313 Aran A and 385 Royal B Cozy 2: 1 skein each 356 Amethyst A and 313 Aran B

Yarn needle

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

**GAUGE:** 12 sts = 4" (10 cm); 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) insingle crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

# Zig-Zag Crochet Cup Cozy

These cozies would make fun teacher or co-worker gifts! Use your favorite color combinations to make each one unique.

Cozy measures 9½" (24 cm) in circumference and 31/4" (8 cm) tall.

#### **NOTES**

Row gauge is not critical.

When changing colors, do not cut yarn between rounds. Instead, pull up a large loop and place it in back of work. When starting a new round, tighten the loop before making the chain 1 to begin the round.

### COZY

With A, ch 28. Join with a slip st to form a ring.

Round 1: Sc in each ch around.

Round 2: Ch 1 (does not count as st here and throughout), \*(sc, ch 1, sc) in next st, skip 1 st; repeat from \* to end, join with a slip st to first sc - 14 [sc, ch 1, sc] groups.

Round 3: Attach B with a slip st in middle of first (sc, ch 1, sc) group, leaving A's loop hanging in back of work (see Note); ch 1, \*(sc, ch 1, sc) in each ch-1 space; repeat from \* to end, ioin with a slip st to first sc.

**Round 4:** Pick up **A**'s loop and pull through first ch-1 space; ch 1, \*(sc, ch 1, sc) in each ch-1 space; repeat from \* to end, join with a slip st to first sc.

Round 5: Pick up B's loop and pull through first ch-1 space: ch 1. \*(sc. ch 1. sc) in each ch-1 space; repeat from \* to end, join with a slip st to first sc. Repeat Rounds 4-5 until cozy measures  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " (7 cm), ending with Round 5.

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Round 1: Pick up A's loop and pull through first sc;

\*sc in next sc, skip ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from \* to end - 28 sc. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

With yarn needle, weave in loose ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**A**. **B** = color A. B: **ch** = chain: **mm** = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
