What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™: 1 ball each 8260 Orange **A**, 8215 Lemon **B**, 8930 Watermelon **C**, 8931 Pink Grapefruit **D**, and 8001 Marshmallow **E**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Rounds 1-5 = 4" (10 cm). Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™, Art. E851 available in 3 oz (85 g), 174 yd (159 m) balls

Flower Granny Square Scrubby

This pretty kitchen scrubby is perfect for washing everything from fruits and vegetables to sticky dishes. The handy strap makes it easy to hold as you wash.

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

SCRUBBY

Square (make 2)

With **A**, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1 (right side): Ch 1, 12 dc in ring; join with slip st in first dc—12 dc. Fasten off.

Round 2: With right side facing and working in spaces between sts, join **B** with slip st in any space, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in same space, 2 dc in each space around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—twelve 2-dc groups. Fasten off.

Round 3: With right side facing and working in spaces between sts, join **C** with slip st in any space, ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 5 dc in same space, *2 dc in next 2 spaces, 6 dc in next space (corner made); repeat from * twice, in last 2 spaces; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—eight 2-dc groups and four 6-dc corners. Fasten off.

Round 4: With right side facing, join **D** with sc in first dc of any 2-dc group, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in 3rd dc of each 6-dc corner; join with slip st in first sc—36 sc and four 3-sc groups.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in center st of each 3-sc group; join with slip st in first sc—44 sc and four 3-sc groups. Fasten off.

Round 6: With right side facing, join **E** with slip st in any sc on any side edge, ch 1, hdc in same st and in each st around, working 3 hdc in center st of each 3-sc group—52 hdc and four 3-hdc groups. Fasten off, leaving a 24" (61 cm) tail on one square.

Strap

With **E** and leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) tail for sewing, ch 14.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—13 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Hold squares with wrong sides together, taking care to match corner sts. With long tail, whipstitch edges together, tucking in short tails to minimize weaving in.

Referring to photograph for placement, sew short edges of strap to midpoints of opposite edges of scrubby. Sew again over stitches just made to reinforce.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
