What you will need:

RED HEART* Scrubby™: 1 ball each 905 Cherry A, 12 Black B, 620 Lime C, 10 Coconut D, and 241 Duckie E

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9].

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4" (10 cm); 15 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Santa's Elf Mitt Scrubby

Here's the best little kitchen helper around!
Our crochet mitt is perfect for holiday party
clean ups and to give your kitchen the spirit
of the season. You may want to make a
second one to help with washing little toes
at a child's bath time

Scrubby measures 5'' wide x 8'' long (12.5 x 21.5 cm).

Special Stitch

Scallop = 5 dc in indicated st.

Note

In front piece, leave long beginning and end tails.

SCRUBBY Front

Note Leave long beginning and end tails for sewing.

With **A**, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—16 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st, turn.

Rows 3-12: Repeat Row 2; change to **B** at end of last row.

Rows 13-16: Repeat Row 2; change to C at end of last row.

Row 17-30: Repeat Row 2. At end of Row 30, fasten off.

Back

Work same as front but do not begin and end with long tails for sewing.

Collar

With **D**, ch 18.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—17 sc.

Row 2: Slip st in first st, *skip next sc, scallop in next sc, skip next sc, slip st in next sc; repeat from * 3 times—4 scallops. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Button (make 2)

With B. ch 2.

Row 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.



Buckle

With B, ch 6.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—5 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each st, turn; change to **E** at end of last row.

Border round: Ch 1, 3 sc in first st, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in last st; working in ends of rows of first side, work 3 sc evenly spaced down to Row 1; working in opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in first ch, sc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in ends of rows of other side, work 3 sc evenly spaced up to first sc; join with slip st in first sc—24 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

Referring to photograph as a guide, sew buckle to **B**-colored section and buttons to **C**-colored section of front.

With wrong sides held together, sew sides and top of front and back together with matching tails, leaving bottom

edge open for wearer's hand. With end tail, sew collar to top of front. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain(s); sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
