What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™: 1 ball each 8929 Strawberry A, 8506 Icepop B, 8930 Watermelon C, 8690 Avocado D, 8215 Lemon E, and 8417 Oyster **F**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

SHOP KIT



Christmas Tree Ornament Scrubbies

Scrubby Sparkle is the perfect choice for crocheting Christmas tree balls to wash the season's party dishes. Or you may want to make one set for the kitchen sink and another set to use as a garland decoration!



Scrubby measures 5" (12.5 cm) in diameter, excluding hanging loop.

SCRUBBY (make 5: 1 each with A & F, B & F, C & F, D & F, and E & F)

With first color, ch 3; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc-6 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc-12 sc.

Round 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-18 sc.

Round 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-24 sc.

Round 5: Ch 1. 2 sc in first st. sc in next 3 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-30 sc.

Round 6: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-36 sc.

Round 7: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 5 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc-42 sc. Fasten off.

Hanging Loop

With right side facing, join F with slip st in any st, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in next 4 sts, turn, ch 8; join with slip st in top of beginning ch. Fasten off.

Chain (optional)

With F, ch 156 or to desired length. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **hdc** = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
