## What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball each 241 Duckie A, 501 Ocean B. and 620 Lime C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm ΓUS H-81

Yarn needle, locking stitch marker

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.

# **Tropical Flower** Scrubby

This fun crocheted square is perfect for making a scrubby to use in your at-home pseudo spa. Choose colors that are bright or more peaceful...whatever makes you happiest!

Scrubby measures 6½" x 6½" (16.5 x 16.5 cm).

#### **Special Stitches**

#### 2-dc Cl (2 double crochet cluster) =

Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, varn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Long sc (long single crochet) = insert hook in indicated stitch 3 rounds below, yarn over and pull up a loop to height of current round, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

## SCRUBBY (Duckie center)

With A, ch 6; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1 (right side): Ch 2, dc in ring (counts as first 2-dc Cl), [ch 1, 2-dc Cl in ring] 7 times, ch 1; join with slip st in first 2-dc Cl-eight 2-dc Cls, 8 ch-1 spaces. Drop loop from hook and place on marker.

Round 2: With right side facing, join B with slip st in any ch-1 space, ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each ch-1 space around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-32 dc and 8 ch-2 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in next dc, slip st in first ch-2 space, ch 3, 5 dc in same space, 6 dc in each ch-2 space around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-48 dc. Fasten off.

Round 4: Place dropped loop on hook, pull up loop to height of current round, ch 1 (counts as first long sc), [sc in next 2 sts, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next st, sc in next

2 sts, long sc in next 2-dc Cl of Round 1, sc in next 5 sts, long sc in next 2-dc Cl of Round 1] around to beginning ch; join with slip st in beginning ch-44 sc, 8 long sc, and 4 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off. **Round 5:** With right side facing, join

C with slip st in any ch-1 space, ch 4 (counts as first tr), [tr, ch 1, 2 tr] in same space, [tr in next 3 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 2 sts, tr in next 3 sts\*, (2 tr, ch 1, 2 tr) in next ch-1 space] around, ending last repeat at \*; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-40 tr, 16 dc, 12 hdc, and 4 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

Round 6: With right side facing, join B with slip st in any ch-1 space, ch 1, 3 sc in same space, sc in next 17 sts, [3] sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next 17 sts1 around; join with slip st in first sc-80 sc. Fasten off.

# SCRUBBY (Ocean center)

Make same as pattern above using Ocean A. Duckie B and Lime C.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet; ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
