What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Cotton™: 1 ball 7760 Lemony

Susan Bates* Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]. Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Scrubby Cotton™, Art. E854 available

in solid color 3.5 oz (100 g) 145 yd (133 m), prints 3 oz (85 g) 121 yd (110 m) balls



Set of Suns Scrubby

Whether you bathe at sun up or sun down, this cotton Scrubby has the right amount of soothing comfort while it invigorates your skin. Crochet this design in any color that coordinates with your bath décor (or perhaps your kitchen sink).

SHOP KIT

Scrubby measures 5" (12.5 cm) in diameter from point to point.

Notes

 Sun is made in joined rounds. Rays are worked back and forth in rows around last round of sun.

Special Stitch

sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Special Techniques

Adjustable-ring method = Wrap yarn into a ring, ensuring that the tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yarn over (with working yarn) and draw up a loop. Work stitches of first round in the ring, working over both strands (the tail and the ring). After the first round of stitches is worked, pull gently, but firmly, on tail to tighten ring.

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

SCRUBBY Sun

Make an adjustable ring, ch 1. **Round 1:** Work 7 hdc in ring; join with

slip st in first hdc—7 hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in same st as join, 2 hdc in each st around, hdc in space between last and first st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—15 hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st as join, hdc in next st, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st] 6 times, hdc in last st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—22 hdc.

Round 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st as join, hdc in next 2 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts] 6 times, hdc in last st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—29 hdc.

Round 5: Ch 2, hdc in same st as join, hdc in next 3 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts] 6 times, hdc in last st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 hdc. Do not fasten off.

Sun Rays

Ray 1

Row 1 (right side): Ch 1, sc in same st as join and in next 3 sts; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in next st, sc2tog, turn—2 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc2tog—1 sc. Fasten off.

Rays 2-8 Row 1 (right side): With right side facing, join yarn with sc in first unworked st, sc in next 3 sts; leave remaining sts unworked, turn—4 sc. Rows 2 and 3: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 of First Sun Ray.

Ray 9

Row 1 (right side): With right side facing, join yarn with sc in first unworked st, sc in last 3 sts, turn—4 sc. Rows 2 and 3: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 of First Sun Ray. Do not fasten off at end of last row.

Edging Round (right side): Ch 1, 2 sc in last sc made; working evenly spaced across ends of rows, work 3 sc in each side edge of rays, working 3 sc in st at top of each ray, sc in same st as first 2 sc; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
