#### What you will need:

**RED HEART**<sup>®</sup> Scrubby<sup>™</sup>: 1 ball each 936 Waves A, 10 Coconut B, and 982 Zesty C

Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



Scrubby<sup>™</sup>, Art. E833 available in MEDIUM solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m) and prints 3 oz (85 g), 78 yd (71 m) balls

# Floral Popcorn Scrubby

Enjoy a refreshing shower or bath as these pretty flowers help smooth your skin. Crocheted with just 4 rounds, you can create a whole bouquet in little time. They dry guickly and wash easily by machine.

Scrubby measures 5" x 5" (12.5 x 12.5 cm).

#### **Special Stitch**

**popcorn =** Work 5 dc in indicated stitch, drop loop from hook, insert hook from front to back in first dc of 5-dc group. place dropped loop back on hook and draw through.

#### **SCRUBBY** (make 2: 1 each with A & B and C & B)

With first color, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc-8 sc.

Round 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st here or throughout), (popcorn, ch 3) in each sc around; join with slip st in beginning ch-2 space-8 popcorns and 8 ch-3 spaces.

Round 3: Ch 2, [popcorn, ch 3] twice in each ch-3 space; change to B; join with slip st in beginning ch-2 space-16 popcorns and 16 ch-3 spaces. Round 4: Ch 1, \*3 sc in next 3 ch-3 spaces, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
