## What you will need:

RED HEART\* Scrubby Cotton™: 1 ball each 7775 Tulip Pink A and 7960 Blushing Print B.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9].

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Rounds 1 and  $2 = 3\frac{1}{2}$ " [9 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

in solid color 3.5 oz (100 g) 145 yd (133 m), prints 3 oz (85 g) 121 yd (110 m) balls



# Here's My Heart Scrubby

Crochet heart scrubbies for those you love! They will enjoy the texture when bathing or washing their face. They're easy to keep clean and fresh—just wash by machine.

SHOP KIT

Scrubby measures about 9" [23 cm] wide and 8" [20.5 cm] tall.

#### Notes

- 1. Scrubby is worked in joined and turned rounds.
- 2. 2 strands of yarn are held together throughout.
- 3. Yarn quantities are sufficient to make 2 scrubbies, one in each color.

#### **Special Stitches**

edc (extended double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 1 loop on hook, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

etr (extended treble crochet) = [Yarn over] twice, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 1 loop on hook, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times.

# SCRUBBY (make 2 - 1 each with A and B)

With 2 strands of yarn held together, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 more dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, turn, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each remaining st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 dc.

**Round 3:** Ch 3, turn, dc in same st as join, dc in next st, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 dc.

Round 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st as join, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, (hdc, dc) in next st, dc in next st, (dc, tr, edc) in next st, dc in next st, (dc, hdc) in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, (dc, tr) in next

st, 2 tr in each of next 2 sts, (tr, dc) in next st, (dc, hdc) in next st, sc in next st, slip st in next st, sc in next st, (hdc, dc) in next st, (dc, tr) in next st, 2 tr in each of next 2 sts, (tr, dc) in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in last st; join with slip st in first sc—50 sts.

Round 5: Ch 1, turn, skip joining slip st, slip st in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, (dc, tr) in next st, 2 tr in next st, (etr, tr) in next st, (tr, dc) in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, slip st in next 5 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, (dc, tr) in next st, (tr, etr) in next st, 2 tr in next st, (tr, dc) in next st, 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in next st; leave remaining sts unworked.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A and B = Color A and Color B; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; () = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.

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
