## What you will need:

### RED HEART® Scrubby

**Cotton™:** 1 ball 7958 Nautical Print

### Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:

5.5mm (US I-9)

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Round 1 = 1¾" (4.5 cm). Gauge is not critical for this project.

# Heart-Shaped Granny Scrubby

Perfect for lathering up in the shower, this scrubby will crochet up quickly when you need a thoughtful gift. Choose any of the multi or solid colors of Scrubby Cotton for an all-natural experience.

**Scrubby measures 6" wide x 6" long (15 x 15 cm).**

## SCRUBBY

Ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Row 1:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), 2 dc in ring, [ch 1, 3 dc in ring] 3 times, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc and 4 ch-1 spaces.

**Row 2:** Slip st in next 2 dc, slip st in first ch-1 space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same space, [ch 1, 3 dc] twice in each ch-1 space around, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 dc and 8 ch-1 spaces.

**Row 3:** Slip st in next 2 dc, slip st in first ch-1 space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same space, \*(ch 1, 3 dc) in next 2 ch-1 spaces, [ch 1, 3 dc] twice in next ch-1 space; repeat from \* once, ch 1, 2 sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—2 sc, 30 dc, and 11 ch-1 spaces.

**Row 4:** Slip st in next 2 dc, slip st in first ch-1 space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same space, [ch 1, 3 dc] twice in next ch-1 space, (ch 1, 3 dc) in next 2 ch-1 spaces, [ch 1, 3 dc] twice in next ch-1 space, (ch 1, 3 dc) in next 2 ch-1 spaces, [ch 1, 3 dc] twice in next 2 ch-1 spaces, ch 1, sc in last 2 ch-1 spaces, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—2 sc, 42 dc, 15 ch-1 spaces.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in each st and ch-1 space around; join with slip st in first sc—59 sc.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet;  
**sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);  
**tr** = treble (triple) crochet; **( )** = work directions in parentheses into same st;  
**[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.



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
