# What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball 241 Duckie A

RED HEART\* Super Saver\*: 1 skein each 319 Cherry Red B and 312 Black C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Scrubby™, Art. E833 available in

solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m) and prints 3 oz (85 g), 78 yd (71 m) balls



RED HEART\* Super Saver\*, Art. E300 available in

# Happy Face Scrubby Emoticons

Whether you use these in the bathroom or kitchen, they will add a happy note to the job at hand. Crochet them quickly in the round and then add the facial features. They are a great gift for social media fans or someone who makes you smile!

Scrubby measures 7½" (19 cm) in diameter.

## **Special Stitch**

**surface slip st (surface slip stitch):** With yarn held on wrong side, insert hook in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, pull loop to right side and through loop on hook.

## **Special Technique**

Adjustable-ring method: Wrap yarn in a ring, ensuring that the tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yarn over (with working yarn) and draw up a loop. Work stitches of first round in ring, working over both strands (the tail and the ring). After the first round of stitches is worked, pull gently, but firmly, on tail to tighten ring.



# **LOVE YA SCRUBBY**

With **A**, make an adjustable loop. **Round 1 (right side):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 11 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc. Pull gently on beginning tail to close loop.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next st, \*dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from

\* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 dc.

**Round 4:** Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, \*dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—48 dc.

**Round 5:** Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, \*dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—60 dc. Fasten off.

#### **FACIAL FEATURES**

## Heart-shaped Eye (make 2)

With **B**, make an adjustable loop. **Round 1 (right side):** Ch 3, (3 dc, 3 hdc, ch 1, 3 hdc, 3 dc, ch 3, slip st) in loop—14 dc and 1 ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Pull gently on beginning tail to close loop.

#### Mouth

With **C**, make an adjustable loop. **Row 1 (right side):** Ch 3, 5 dc in loop, turn—6 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in first dc, 2 dc in each remaining st across, turn—12 dc.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in first dc, dc in next st, \*2 dc in next st, dc in next st; repeat from \* across—18 dc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Pull gently on beginning tail to close loop.

# **FINISHING**

Refer to photograph as a guide and position all pieces with right sides facing. Place eyes and mouth where desired on first scrubby and sew in place.

Weave in ends.

# **SMILEY FACE SCRUBBY**

Work same as Love Ya Scrubby.

## **FACIAL FEATURES**

Eye (make 2)

With **C**, make an adjustable loop. **Round 1 (right side):** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 9 dc in loop; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—10 hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Pull gently on beginning tail to close loop.

## **Smile**

Insert hook in any space between Rounds 3 and 4, with yarn held on wrong side of scrubby, place **C**-colored slip knot on hook and draw through to right side, work 20 surface slip sts loosely between same rounds. Fasten off, drawing end tail to wrong side.

## **FINISHING**

Referring to photograph as a guide, position eyes where desired above smile and sew in place.

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain(s); dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
