What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™: 1 ball each of 8260 Orange A, 8690 Avocado B, 8012 Licorice C

Susan Bates Crochet Hook*: 4.0mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sc and 10 rows sc = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



SHOP KIT



Jack o' Lantern Scrubby

This happy pumpkin has a sparkling personality thanks to the Scrubby Sparkle yarn! He's fun to crochet and give as an alternative to sweet treats for Halloween. He's perfect for use in the bath or at the kitchen sink!

Scrubby measures: $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x $7\frac{3}{4}$ " (19.7 x 19.7 cm)

Special Stitch

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st]
twice, yarn over and draw through all 3
loops on hook.

PUMPKIN

With **A**, beginning at bottom Edge, ch

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across; turn—12 sc.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch), sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc; turn—14 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 4 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc; turn—20 sc.

Rows 4-9: Repeat Row 2—32 sc.

Rows 10-19: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in each sc across to last 3 sc, sc2tog; sc in last sc; turn—30 sc.

Rows 21-25: Repeat Row 20-20 sc.

Right Top

Row 26: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog, sc in next sc; turn, leaving last 10 sts unworked—8 sc. Row 27: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog; turn—6 sc.

Row 28: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog; turn—4 sc. Fasten off.

Left Top

Referring to photo for placement, join A in first unworked sc at center of Row 25. Row 29: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc; turn—8 sc.

Row 30: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog; turn—6 sc.

Row 31: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog; turn—4 sc. (Do not fasten off.)

EDGE

With Right Side facing, ch 1, sc around outside edge of pumpkin, working sts into sides of Rows as needed to keep work flat, and working a slip st in the bottom of the top center "V." Fasten off varn and weave in ends.

STEM

With B, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across: turn—4 sc.

Rows 2-3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn—4 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn—6 sc.

Rows 5-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn—6 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc—8 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Referring to photo for placement, sew stem to pumpkin.

EYE (make 2)

With **C**, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across: turn—4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn—4 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc2tog twice; turn-2 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc2tog—1 st.

Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Referring to photo for placement, sew eyes in place with Row 4 at the top of each.

NOSE

Make nose same as eye.

Referring to photo for placement, sew nose in place with Row 1 at the top.

MOUTH

With C, ch 6.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across; turn—5 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn—7 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn—9 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

Referring to photo for placement, sew Mouth in place.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; () = work all directions in parentheses in the indicated stitch or space; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
