Cherry Pie Scrubby

Next time you are invited to dinner or a dessert party, bring along a cherry pie scrubby for your host. The unique crocheted texture is perfect for quickly cleaning dishes, pots and even the kitchen sink. The polyester fiber dries easily and can be washed by machine to keep it fresh.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball each 938 Almond **A**, 709 Bubblegum **B**, 10 Coconut **C** and 905 Cherry **D**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Scrubby™, Art. E833 available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m), prints 3.0 oz (85 g) 78 yds (71 m) balls

SHOP KIT

Scrubby measures 7½" [19 cm] across at widest point.

NOTE

Each part of Scrubby is made separately and then pieces are sewed together.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Bpdc: (back post double crochet) Yo, insert hook from back to front then to back, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Skip st in front of the Bpdc.

Fpdc: (front post double crochet) Yo, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Skip st behind the Fpdc.

hdc2tog: [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop] 2 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

Shell: 5 dc in same stitch

CRUST

With **A**, ch 18.

Set-Up Row (Wrong Side): Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across – 15 dc.

Row 1: Ch 2 (does not count as stitch here and throughout), turn, hdc in first st, Fpdc, *Bpdc, Fpdc; repeat from * to last st, hdc in last st.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, hdc in first st, Bpdc, *Fpdc, Bpdc; repeat from * to last st, hdc in last st.

Repeat Rows 1-2 once more, then Row 1 once. Fasten off.

PIE

With **B**, ch 22.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, [skip next ch, Shell in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch] 5 times, turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, *sc in next sc, sc in skipped ch, sc in Shell, sc in skipped ch; repeat from * to last st, sc in last st.

Rows 2-3: Working along straight edge only, ch 2, turn, hdc in each st to end – 21 hdc.

Row 4: Ch 2, turn, [hdc2tog] twice, hdc in each st to last 4 sts, [hdc2tog] twice – 17 hdc.

Row 5: Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, *hdc in next st, hdc2tog; repeat from * to end – 11 hdc.

Row 6: Ch 2, turn, [hdc2tog] twice, hdc in next 2 sts, [hdc2tog] twice, hdc in last st – 7 hdc.

Row 7: Ch 2, turn, [hdc2tog] twice, hdc in next st, hdc2tog – 4 hdc. Fasten off.

CREAM TOP

With **C**, ch 14.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, [skip next ch, Shell in next ch, skip next ch, sc in next ch] 3 times, turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1, *sc in sc, sc in skipped ch, sc in Shell, sc in skipped ch; repeat from * to last st, sc in sc.

Row 2: Working along straight edge only, ch 2, turn, [hdc2tog] 3 times, hdc in next st, [hdc2tog] 3 times – 7 hdc.

Continued...



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Row 3: Ch 2, turn, [hdc2tog] twice, hdc in next st, hdc2tog – 4 hdc. Fasten off.

CHERRY

With **D**, ch 4, slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, work 10 sc in ring. Fasten off.

STEM

With **A**, ch 10. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew lower scalloped edge of Pie along last row of Crust.

With scalloped edge as lower edge, sew Cream centered along top edge of Pie. Sew Cherry in center of top edge of Cream. Fold Stem in half and sew ends to top edge of Cream.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
