What you will need:

RED HEART° Scrubby Sparkle": 1 ball each 8260 Orange A, 8215 Lemon B, 8690 Avocado C, and 8001 Marshmallow D

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6]

GAUGE: Rounds 1–4 = 3¾" (9.5 cm) in double crochet. Exact gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™, Art E851 available in 3 oz (85 g) 174 yd (159 m) balls



Splash of Citrus Scrubby

You'll love these citrus rounds for washing dishes or scrubbing the sink! This textured yarn has a sparkle effect, is easy to crochet with and can be thrown in the washing machine to keep it fresh. Scrubby measures 7½" (19 cm) in diameter.

Note

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

Special Stitch

Fpdc (Front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

SCRUBBY (make 1 each with A, B, and C)

Ch 4.

Round 1: Work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc. Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), Fpdc around first dc, *dc in next dc, Fpdc around same dc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, Fpdc around same dc, *dc in next 2 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 dc.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked, *dc in next 3 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—48 dc.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked, *dc in next 4 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—60 dc.

Round 6: Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked, *dc in next 5 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—72 dc.

Round 7: Ch 3, dc in next 5 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked, *dc in next 6 dc, Fpdc around last dc worked; repeat from * around; change to **D**; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—84 dc.

Round 8: Ch 1, sc in first 6 dc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—96 sc. Fasten off.

Round 9: Working in back loops only, join first color with sc in back loop of first sc, sc in each sc around, (slip st, ch 10, slip st) in first sc (hanging loop made), turn, slip st in each ch; join with slip st in same sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain(s); dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
