## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby™:** 1 ball  
each 905 Cherry A and 709  
Bubblegum B

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

Gauge is not critical with this  
project.



**RED HEART®**  
**Scrubby™**, Art. E833  
available 3.5 oz (100 g),  
92 yd (85 m) balls



# Valentine Scrubby

*Give this heart-shaped Scrubby to make their  
dishwashing or bathing a time to remember that  
they are loved. Choose from any of the wonderful  
shades of this yarn...no one says crochet hearts  
have to be red!*

SHOP KIT

**Scrubby measures 9" wide x 8½" long (23  
x 21.5 cm).**

## Special Stitch

**dc2tog** = [Yarn over, insert hook in next  
stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over,  
draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over,  
draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## Special Technique

**Join with sc** = Place a slip knot on hook,  
insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over  
and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw  
through both loops on hook.

## SCRUBBY

With **A**, ch 4.

**Row 1 (right side):** Work 5 dc in 4th ch  
from hook (beginning ch count as first dc),  
turn—6 dc.

**Rows 2–10:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here  
and throughout), dc in first dc (same as  
base of beginning ch-3), dc in each st across  
to beginning ch, 2 dc in top of beginning ch,  
turn—24 dc.

**Row 11:** Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

## First Lobe

**Row 12:** Ch 3, dc in next 11 dc; leave  
remaining sts unworked, turn—12 dc.

**Rows 13–15:** Ch 3, dc2tog, dc in each st to  
last 3 sts, dc2tog, dc in top of beginning ch,  
turn—6 dc.  
Fasten off.

## 2nd Lobe

**Row 12 (wrong side):** With wrong side  
facing, skip first unworked st, join **A** with  
slip st in next unworked st, ch 3, dc in each  
remaining st across, turn—12 dc.

**Rows 13–15:** Repeat Rounds 13–15 of first  
lobe. Do not fasten off at end of last round.

## Edging

**Round 1:** Ch 1, working in ends of rows,  
sts, and opposite side of foundation ch, sc  
evenly spaced around, adding sc as needed  
to keep piece flat and working 3 sc in  
foundation ch (base of 6 dc of Row 1); join  
with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** With right side facing, join **B** with  
sc in center st of 3-sc group at bottom of  
piece, \*ch 2, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat  
from \* around, adding sc as need to keep  
piece flat; join with slip st in first sc. Do not  
turn.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in each ch-2  
space around; join with slip st in first sc.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B** = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain(s);  
**dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet;  
**st(s)** = stitch(es); **( )** = work directions  
in parentheses into same st; \* = repeat  
whatever follows the \* as indicated.



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
