## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby™:** 1 ball each 905 Cherry **A** and 10 Coconut **B**.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



**RED HEART® Scrubby™**, Art. E833 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m) balls

# Peppermint Scrubby

*Freshen up your kitchen or scrub those plates clean with this festive crocheted helper. It's even great for washing your face! This unique polyester yarn can be washed by machine and air dries quickly. Make them for the perfect hostess gift or stocking stuffer.*

**Scrubby measures about 8" [20.5 cm] diameter, not including hanging loop.**

## Notes

1. Scrubby is worked in joined rounds, with same side facing at all times. Do not turn at the end of rounds.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## PINWHEEL

With **A**, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** With **A**, ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 11 more dc in ring changing to **B** in last dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3—12 dc.

**Round 2:** With **B**, ch 3, dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each of remaining 11 sts changing to **A** in last dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3—24 dc.

**Round 3:** With **A**, ch 3, 2 dc in next st, [dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] 11 times changing to **B** in last dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3—36 dc.

**Round 4:** With **B**, ch 3, dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, [2 dc in next 2 sts, dc in next st] 11 times changing to **A** in last dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3—60 dc.

**Round 5:** With **A**, ch 3, 2 dc in next st, [dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] 29 times changing to **B** in last dc; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3—90 dc.

**Round 6:** With **B**, ch 3, dc in each st around changing to **A** in last st; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3.

**Round 7:** With **A**, ch 1, sc in same st as joining, skip next st, [2 sc in next st, skip next st] 44 times; join with slip st in first sc.  
**Hanging Loop:** With **A**, ch 12, slip st in same st as joining; leave remaining sts unworked. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A and B** = Color A and Color B; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



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
